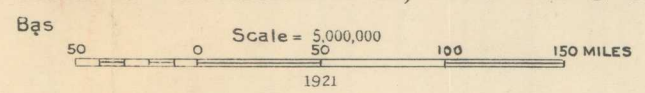
Reserves of iron in ore  
 Circles are drawn on scale shown in diagram, in which the unit circle represents the world's output of pig iron in 1913 (about 80,000,000 metric tons). Solid color, known reserve; shaded, probable reserve; open circle, possible reserve. Outlines of districts are shown where known
