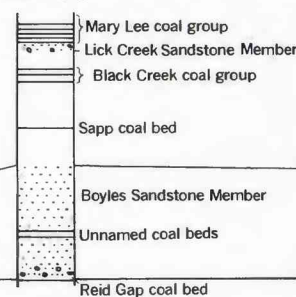


INDEX MAP OF NORTH ALABAMA

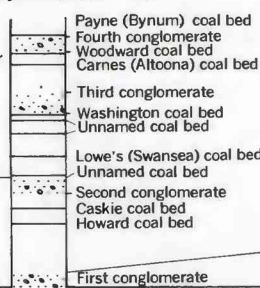

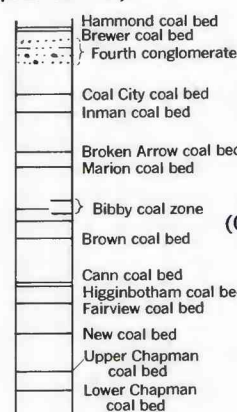

outcrops)



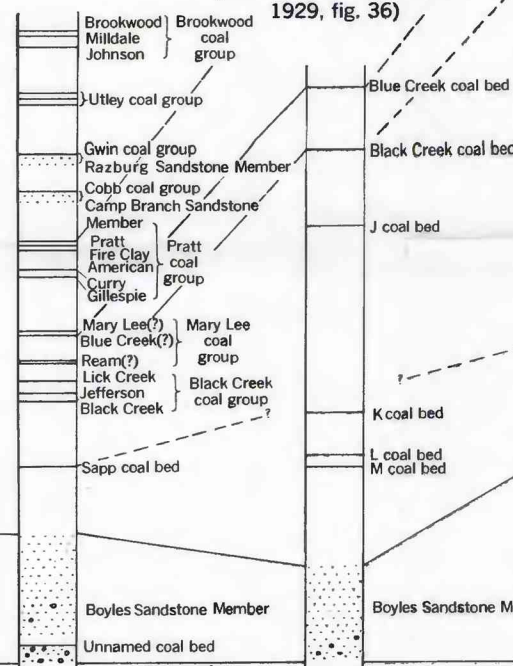

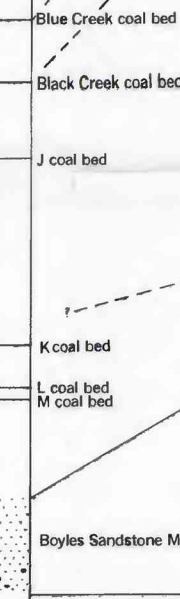

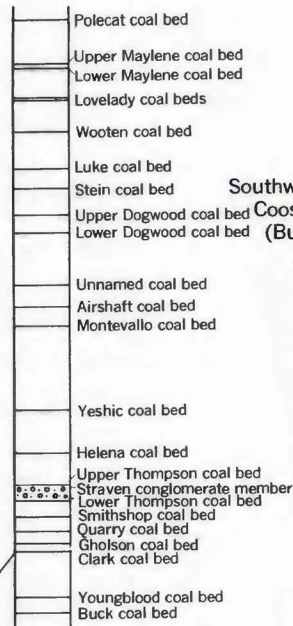

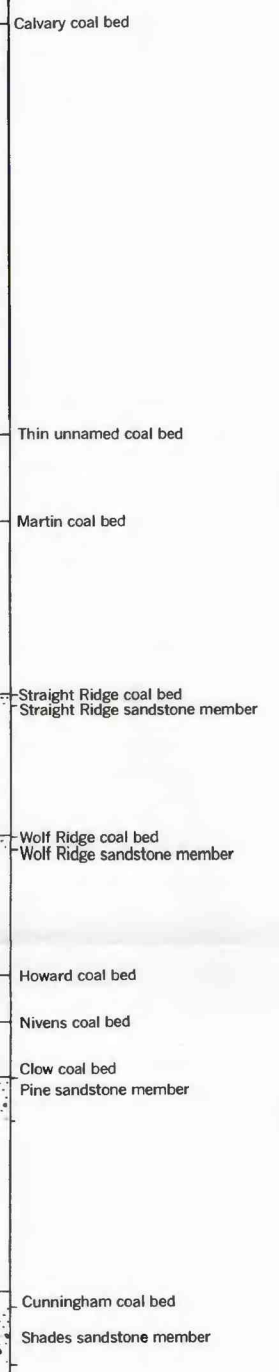
