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INTRODUCTION

Several groups of workers in the USGS are involved in research projects in the Clear Lake-Geysers area in Napa, Sonoma, Lake and Mendocino Counties, California. We anticipate the preparation of a publication that will give an overview of both USGS and other research in this area on environmental and geologic problems. This preliminary bibliography is intended eventually for that publication; it is being circulated now in order to elicit corrections, additions, and other comments from anyone who cares to make them.

These references are the result of merging the reference lists of several workers, including D. P. Adam, R. W. Casteel, J. M. Donnelly, F. E. Goff, B. C. Hearn, Jr., W. F. Isherwood, R. J. McLaughlin, M. J. Rymer, and J. D. Sims. References were contributed in a number of styles; while I have attempted to make all references conform to a single format, this has not always been possible. My compilation work has consisted mainly of merging the various lists, eliminating duplications, and correcting obvious errors. I have not checked all references against original sources, and some errors doubtless remain.

We hope that many more references dealing with the Clear Lake-Geysers area will be included in the final version of this bibliography, especially the more obscure sources, such as environmental impact statements, dissertations, and theses, that are unpublished but still available to the public.
