



Photomosaic and Interpretive Tracing of the Dakota Sandstone, Mesa Butte Area

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Plate 1. Photomosaic and interpretive tracing (used in figure 15B) showing mapped surfaces and channel-form deposits of the Dakota Sandstone in the Mesa Butte area. Tracing emphasizes the channel geometry (colors), and internal mudrock intervals (gray). The Dakota is enclosed within mudrock facies of the Tununk Member of the Mancos Shale and Cedar Mountain Formation. Scale only applies to the central part of the mosaic and interpretive tracing.
