

MAP OF ALASKA

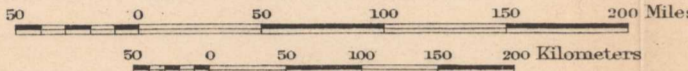
SHOWING DISTRIBUTION OF MINERAL DEPOSITS
