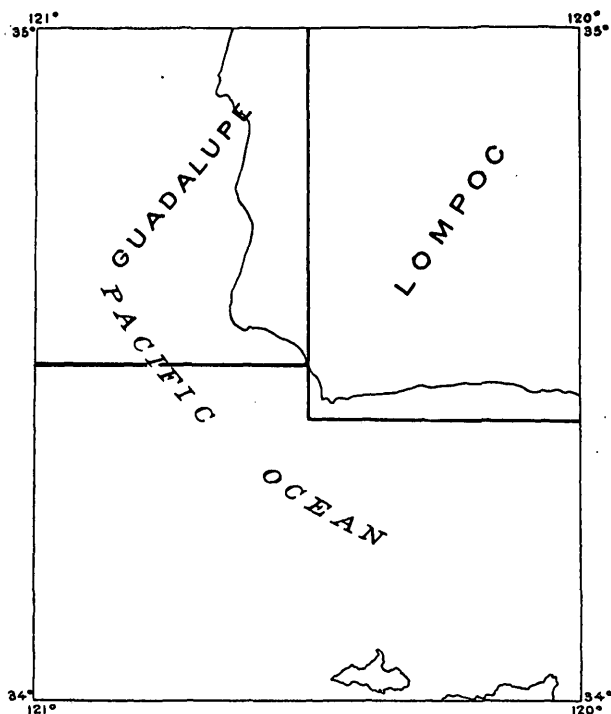


FIGURE 16.—Diagram of degree quadrangle 34°-35°, 120°-121°
