


EXPLANATION

-  Area in which reserves of anthracite and semianthracite were estimated
-  Area in which reserves of anthracite and semianthracite were not estimated, but which may be underlain by minable reserves with less than 3,000 feet of overburden
-  Area in which reserves of bituminous coal were estimated
-  Area in which reserves of bituminous coal were not estimated, but which may be underlain by minable reserves with less than 3,000 feet of overburden
-  Area in which reserves of subbituminous coal were estimated
-  Area in which reserves of subbituminous coal were not estimated, but which may be underlain by minable reserves with less than 3,000 feet of overburden
-  Area in which bituminous coal beds are generally thin, impure, or discontinuous, but may locally contain minable reserves. Overburden is less than 3,000 feet
-  Area in which bituminous-coal-bearing rocks are 3,000 feet or more below the surface
-  Area in which subbituminous coal beds are probably more than 3,000 feet below the surface
