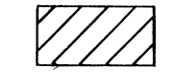


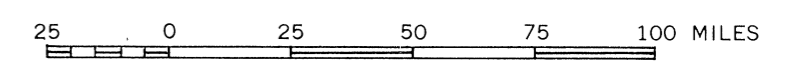
EXPLANATION
