STATEMENT OF BUREAU FUNCTIONS AND ACTIVITIES

Office of Surface Mining

The primary goal of the Office of Surface Mining is to create a nationwide program that protects ciety and the environment adverse effects of coal mining operations while ensuring an adequate supply of coal to meet the Nation's energy needs.

Regional Offices headed by Regional Directors serve as line managerial, administrative, and technical support and operations offices. administers specific geographic areas consisting of several states and one or more Standard Federal Regions.

Regional Directors are responsible for activities in their respective regions, including providing a focal point for the States, industry, private and public interest groups, operators, and other Federal agencies within the region; recommending and providing financial aid and assistance to States and their coal mining reclamation program offices; reviewing and monitoring State regulatory programs; conducting a Federal regulatory authority where applicable, including regulatory programs on Federal and Indian lands; administering an abandoned lands program; and recommending to the Director the formulation or change of policy, legislative needs, regulations, and guide- of the public lands

lines. Regional Offices monitor and direct District Office operations, provide technical and administrative support District Offices, perform delegated administrative responsibilities.

typical Regional Office has organization components technical administration, inspection and enforcement, abandoned mine lands reclamation, and administration of State, Indian, and Federal lands programs.

District Offices, under the direction of Regional Directors headed by District managers, perform assigned operational activities within a designated geographic area. inspect mining operations and provide direct oversight to State programs. Where there is a Federal program or a Federal lands program, they may review and approve applications for permits, provide appropriate assistance within limits of the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act to mine operators in complying with the Act, and conduct reclamation of abandoned mine lands. A District Office may include subordinate field offices which are responsible for conducting inspections within a local area.

Bureau of Land Management

The Bureau of Land Management is responsible for (BLM) the agement, protection, and development and

owned minerals. This includes total management of 357 million acres of public lands, primarily in the West and in Alaska, and subsurface resource management of an additional 410 million acres of other Federally or privately owned lands where mineral rights have been reserved to the Federal Government. The Office of Coal Management (OCM), within the BLM Washington Office, is responsible, in coordination with the Department of the Interior, for the formulation of policy, programs, procedures, and necessary guidance concerning the Federal coal management program. Under the authority of the BLM Director, Assistant to the Director for Coal Management directs all BLM coal program activities and renders final decisions of the coal program within the limits and authority delegated by the Director, the Assistant Secretary for Land and Water Resources. and the Secretary of the Interior.

The OCM provides a single BLM Washington Office contact for the Assistant Secretary's Office, the Director, the BLM field offices, other Federal agencies, Congress, industry, interest groups, and the general public regarding the Federal coal management program. The OCM activities include monitoring Federal coal production region activity planning actions, preparing regional environmental impact statements (EIS's), and site-specific coal EIS's and environmental assessments (EA's), overseeing procedures of coal lease issuance. providing reliable data on Federal coal leases, and disseminating information on the coal program.

The BLM State Offices, each under the auspices of a State Director and Associate State Director, are the field level supervisory and operational offices that administer the Federal coal management program. Each State activity Office oversees the coal planning actions in the portion of each Federal coal production region

within its administrative jurisdiction. The State Office has authority over District and Area Offices within its administrative area. The State Office oversees the development of site-specific coal-related EIS's and EA's, prepares land-use plans, adjudicates coal leases, keeps coal records and appropriate maps and plats, and is the BLM contact at the field level for Federal coal matters within its jurisdiction. In cases where more than one BLM State Office is within part of a Federal coal production region, a specific BLM State Office is designated the responsible lead State Office for overseeing the regional coal EIS preparation within the established schedule for lease sale deci-A State Office Project Manasions. ger, designated by the lead State Office Director, is responsible for the daily management and oversight of the regional coal EIS effort and is responsible for coordination between the affected BLM States, other Federal agencies, State agencies, and the Regional Coal Team within the Federal coal production region in regard to the specific regional coal EIS. State Office also has a designated Coal Coordinator who is a contact for individual coal-related matters within the State Office area of jurisdiction. Matters dealing with specific coal leases, coal applications, coal exchanges, preference right applications, coal exploration licenses, and land-use planning are dealt with by each State Office. The State Office also assures that proper coordination is accomplished with other Federal management agencies having surface jurisdiction over Federal coal minerals.

The District Offices, headed by a District Manager, develop and carry out management of the Federal coal management program within the geographic subdivisions of each appropriate BLM State area of jurisdiction. Each District Office is responsible where the Federal coal occurrence is for the conduct of inventories and preparation of land-use plans for the public lands and Federally owned minerals within their area of jurisdiction, which also includes application of the 20 unsuitability criteria. District Office is also responsible for regional coal activity actions within its specific jurisdictions, the preparation of site-specific EA's and EIS's on coal actions, and the development of lease stipulations, terms and conditions, and special provisions necessary to protect and manage the public land resources. Enforcement of lease stipulations and provisions is also the responsibility of District Offices.

Districts are subdivided into Resource Areas and, in some states, Project Offices, headed by Area Managers and Project Offices Managers, respectively. It is the responsibility of the Area and Project Office Managers to support the District Offices in the gathering and analysis of inventory data, preparation of landuse plans, and preparation of coal site-specific EA's. Area and Project Offices conduct much of the on-theground gathering of data and information necessary to manage the public lands and Federally owned minerals.

Public contact concerning the use and management of the BLM public lands in regard to Federal coal matters occurs at the Resource Area, District Office, and State Office level as well as at the Washington Office level. Specific Federal coal management program matters within a specific State are coordinated through appropriate BLM State Office. Broad program, policy, and procedural Federal coal management issues are appropriately coordinated through the Washington Office of Coal Management.

Geological Survey

The U.S. Geological Survey, through its Organic Act of 1879, is mandated to assess the mineral resources of the United States. The

U.S.G.S. carries out that through surveys, investigations, and research in all aspects of Earth Other broad objectives of sciences. the U.S.G.S. are to investigate the mineral and water resources of the United States; classify land as to mineral character and water and power resources; enforce departmental regulations applicable to oil, gas, and other mining leases, permits, licenses, development contracts, and gas storage contracts; and publish disseminate data relative to the foregoing activities. Three of the Geological Survey's eight operating divisions are most active in the coal Water Resources Division, program: Conservation Division, and Geologic The activities of each of Division. these division is described below.

General direction of the Water Resources Division field program is through four Regional Hydrologists. Each Regional Hydrologist, with authority from the Chief Hydrologist, is responsible for the water resources programs and projects conducted by the District Offices, Research Project Offices, and the central water quality laboratory within the particular region. Through the Regional Hydrologists, the Water Resources Division provides the hydrologic information and understanding needed for the optimum utilization and management of the Nation's water resources. This is accomplished, in large part, through cooperation with other Federal and non-Federal agencies by: collecting, on a systematic basis, data needed for the continuing determination and evaluation of the quantity, quality, and use of the Nation's water resources; (2) conducting analytical and interpretive water resource appraisals describing the occurrence, availability, and the physical, chemical, and biological characteristics of surface and ground water; (3) conducting supportive basic and problemoriented research in hydraulics, hy-The drology, and related fields of science

to improve the scientific basis for | investigations and measurement techniques and to understand hydrologic systems sufficiently well to quantitatively predict their response stress, either natural or manmade; (4) disseminating the water data and the results of these investigations and research through reports, maps, computerized information services, other forms of public releases; coordinating the activities of Federal agencies in the acquisition of and access to water data for streams, lakes, reservoirs, estuaries, and waters; and (6) providing scientific and technical assistance in hydrologic fields to other Federal, State, and local agencies and to licensees of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

Through the Regional Conservation Managers, the Conservation Division exercises its overall responsibility for the classification and evaluation of Federal mineral lands multiple-use management and leasing and for the regulation of operations on leased Federal and Indian lands. In carrying out this overall responsibility, the Regional Conservation Manager identifies areas for competitive leasing of minerals and provides geologic, economic, and engineering support for lease sales. The inventory and classification of leasable mineral resources on Federal lands are also a responsibility of the Manager. Acting in an advisory the Regional Conservation capacity, Manager furnishes data on minerals on Federal lands to the Federal land management Agencies land-use planning, multiple use, or best use decisions and to Congress or other Federal Agencies for land withdrawal decisions by Congressional or Executive action.

After leasing occurs, the Regional Conservation Manager supervises and inspects mineral production and exploration operations on Federal, Inand acquired land leases in cable statutes, regulations, orders, and lease stipulations. Additionally, the Regional Conservation Manager is authorized to collect royalties from leasable mineral production operations and to manage the accounts of these operations.

The Geologic Division performs detailed investigations and research in coal resources, environmental and engineering geology, coal and regional geochemistry, geologic hazards regarding coal development, computer storage and handling of coal-resource information, and reclamation of mined land. Direction of the Geologic Division is carried out by the Chief Geologist and his staff and by a Regional Geologist in each region.

The Regional Geologist is responsible in each particular region for: broad review and analysis of ongoing programs in order to advise the Chief Geologist and staff on matters concerning improvements in quality, direction, and management of Geologic Division activities in the context of regional needs; identifying, coordinating, and proposing to the Chief Geologist and staff new program concepts that are responsive to regional needs and national interests; and fostering coordination of Division and interdivision activities to insure that broad multidisciplinary techniques are considered in problem solving. Regional Geologist represents the Chief Geologist in contacts with the public at large and is responsible for maintaining contact with other Divisions within the Survey, Federal, State and local government agencies, universities, foundations, and industry in order to keep them informed of Geologic Division activities and to propose, coordinate and review cooperative programs and matters of mutual Among the Geologic Division concern. programs are: investigations relating to the origin, character, distribution, appraisal, and techniques for exploration for coal resources; surorder to insure compliance with appli- | face and subsurface geologic mapping;




