Petroleum Systems and Geologic Assessment of Undiscovered Oil and Gas, Navarro and Taylor Groups, Western Gulf Province, Texas

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Photograph shows the Cretaceous-Paleocene contact on the Rio Grande River at White Bluff, about 5 mi from the Webb County line, in Maverick County, Texas. Contact lies at base of projecting ledge. Basal ledge is approximately 2 ft thick. Rocks below basal ledge are assigned to the Upper Cretaceous Escondido Formation; rocks forming the ledges and to the top of the outcrop are assigned to the Tertiary Midway Group. [Photograph by L.W.
