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Groundwater-Quality Data in the Madera–Chowchilla Study Unit, 2008: Results from the California GAMA Program

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NOTE for clarification:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency maximum contaminant level (MCL-US) for 1,2-dibromoethane (EDB) was incorrectly reported as 0.02 micrograms per liter ($\mu\text{g/L}$) in Table 5. The MCL-US for EDB is 0.05 $\mu\text{g/L}$. Therefore, there were no detections of EDB above the MCL-US.

The U.S. Geological Survey National Water Quality Laboratory reporting level (LRL) for low-level EDB was incorrectly reported as 0.04 $\mu\text{g/L}$ in Table 5. The LRL for EDB is 0.02 $\mu\text{g/L}$.

3,4-Dichloroaniline was incorrectly reported as having a California Department of Public Health maximum contaminant level (MCL-CA) of 1 $\mu\text{g/L}$ in Table 6A. . No MCL-CA exists for 3,4-dichloroaniline.
