NOTE for clarification:
The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency maximum contaminant level (MCL-US) for 1,2-dibromoethane (EDB) was incorrectly reported as 0.02 micrograms per liter (μ g/L) in Table 5. The MCL-US for EDB is 0.05 μ g/L. Therefore, there were no detections of EDB above the MCL-US.
The U.S. Geological Survey National Water Quality Laboratory reporting level (LRL) for low-level EDB was incorrectly reported as 0.04 μ g/L in Table 5. The LRL for EDB is 0.02 μ g/L.
$3,4\text{-Dichloroaniline}$ was incorrectly reported as having a California Department of Public Health maximum contaminant level (MCL-CA) of 1 $\mu\text{g/L}$ in Table 6A No MCL-CA exists for 3,4-dichloroaniline.
