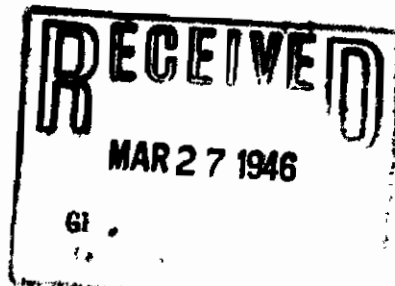

5600-5605	Recovered 1/2 lime and dolomite. No cut slight taste of oil or gas. Preparing to make Drill Stem test.
