

CONDENSED DRILLER'S LOG

- (1) Surface - 700': Limestone, fresh water aquifer
  - 700' - 2815': Limestone, brackish and salt water
  - 2815' - 2923': Midway Shale
  - 2923' - 3590': Chalk
  - 3590' - 4330': Mostly gray shale with thin sand beds
  - 4330' - 10480': Red sandstones interbedded with red shales of Lower Cretaceous and Jurassic age
  - 10480' - 11420': Red and dark gray shale with thin sand beds
  - 11420' - 12131': Red and light tan shale with minor amounts of Basaltic Igneous material
- (2) Cement returns were obtained in the setting of the 13-3/8" surface casing.
- (3) No drill stem tests were conducted.

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
