Dear Jose:

I am sending you in a tube some rough drafts of the two (2) wells which relate to the possibility of developing disposal wells at Sarasota. Please note that lost circulation zones occur and can be correlated between the Mobil No. 1 Schroeder-Manatee Well and the offshore Mobil Well in Charlotte County. These zones occur approximately at 4,000 feet and around 4,800 feet. The California Company No. 3, Florida State Lease Well in Pinellas County had good cavernous sections at 3,000 plus and 4,000 minus feet. Therefore, it would appear that we should anticipate cavernous areas somewhere between 3,000 and 4,000 feet at Sarasota and although the data are extremely limited, there would appear to be excellent chances of developing the zone.

If you can get your draftsman to draft these charts up, so that they can be reduced and used in your report, please send me a copy of the final drafted section.
