phosphatic fish remains
- 415 - 475 cts - - - - - Tampa (?)

Elevation: 66'

- 0-20 Sand with clay - light brown, sand med to coarse.
- 20-25 Sand - light brown, fine to coarse.
- 25-75 Sand with little clay - light gray and light brown, sand med to very coarse.
- 75-120 Sand with clay - light gray.
- 120-180 Sand with very little gravel - coarse to very coarse.
- 180-215 Sand with very little clay - med green gray, sand med with some coarse and very coarse.
- 215-225 Sand - coarse to very coarse.
- 225-250 Same as 180-215.
- 250-270 Sand with flakes of claystone ? - coarse to very coarse, claystone ? resembles siderite but much softer.
- 270-300 Sand with little clay - light gray, sand fine to med with some coarse.
- 300-350 Sand with very little clay - light gray, sand med to coarse.
- 350-355 Sand - coarse.
- 355-430 Sand with very little clay - light green-gray, sand fine to coarse.
- 430-450 Sand - coarse to very coarse.
- 450-460 Same as 355-430.
- 460-480 Sand with siderite and phosphate - coarse to very coarse.
- 480 - TD Lime with shells and little sand and phosphate.
