- 0-5 Sand - light brown, med, well sorted.
- 5-30 Sand - med - dark brown, fine to med, abundant lignite.
- 30-45 Sand and clay - med gray, sand fine to med.
- 45-60 Sand with little clay - med gray, sand coarse.
- 60-70 Sand and clay - med to light gray, sand med.
- 70-110 Sand with little clay and few shells - med gray, sand med.
- 110-185 Sand with little gravel - light brown to light gray, sand coarse to very coarse.
- 185-205 Sand with clay - light gray-green, sand med to coarse.
- 205-240 Sand - med gray-brown, sand coarse to very coarse.
- 240-250 Sand with little clay - light green-gray, sand med.
- 250-305 Sand with clay - med green, sand med to coarse.
- 305-320 Sand - med gray, coarse to very coarse.
- 320-370 Sand with little clay and few shells - med green-gray, sand med to coarse.
- 370-385 Sand with clay and little lime - light gray-green, sand coarse.
- 385-445 Sand with very little lime and few shells - light gray, sand fine to med.
- 445-505 Sand with lime and few shells - med gray, sand med to coarse.
- 505-843 Lime with shells and sand.
