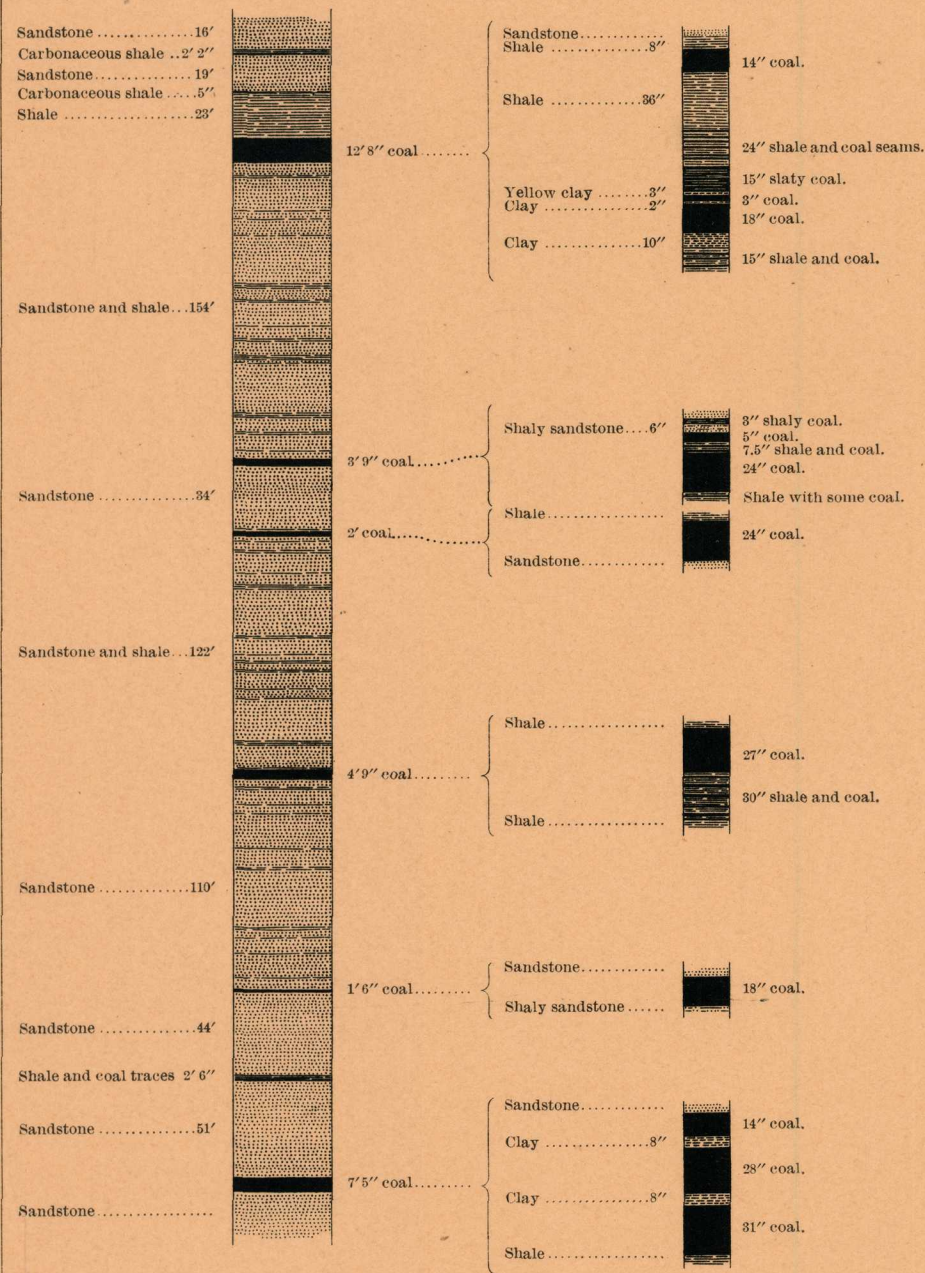


FIG. 9.—SECTION OF COAL-BEARING ROCKS AT BEAVER HILL.

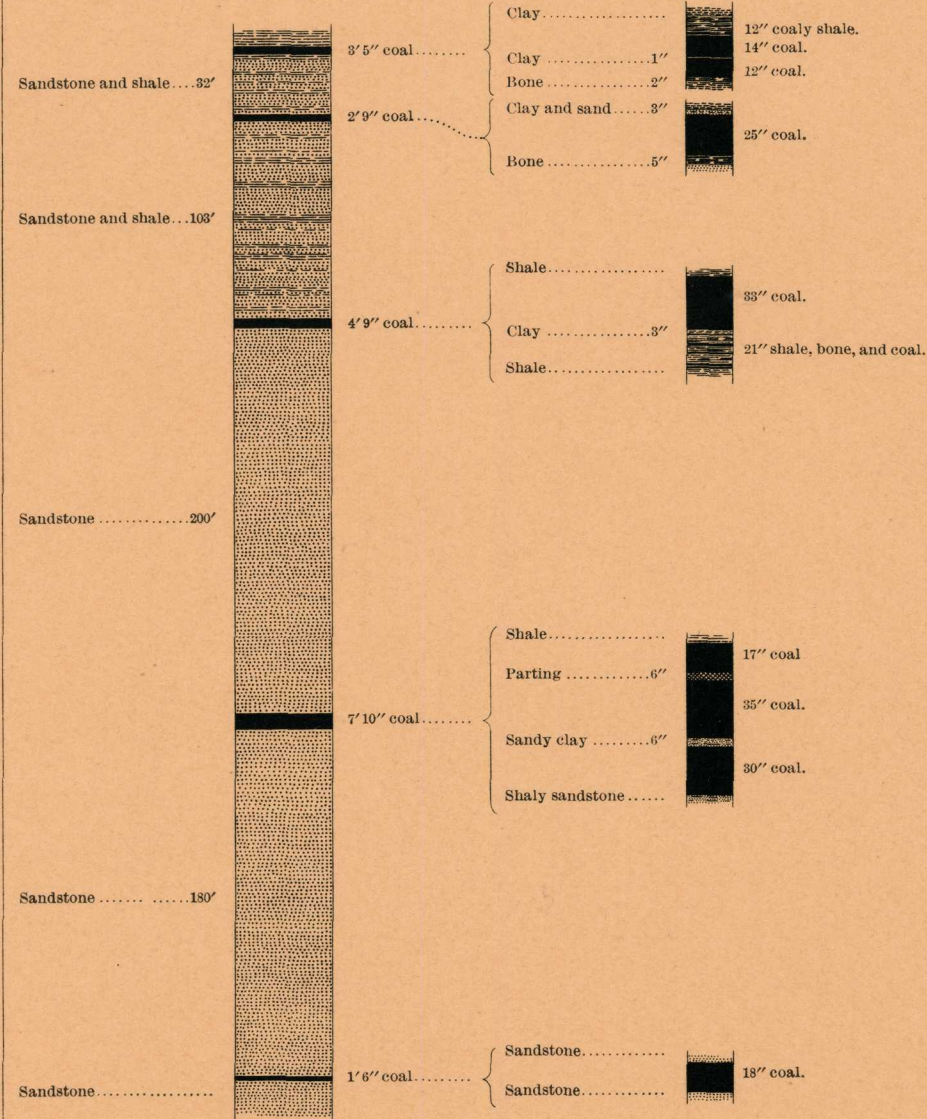


FIG. 10.—SECTION OF COAL-BEARING ROCKS AT RIVERTON.

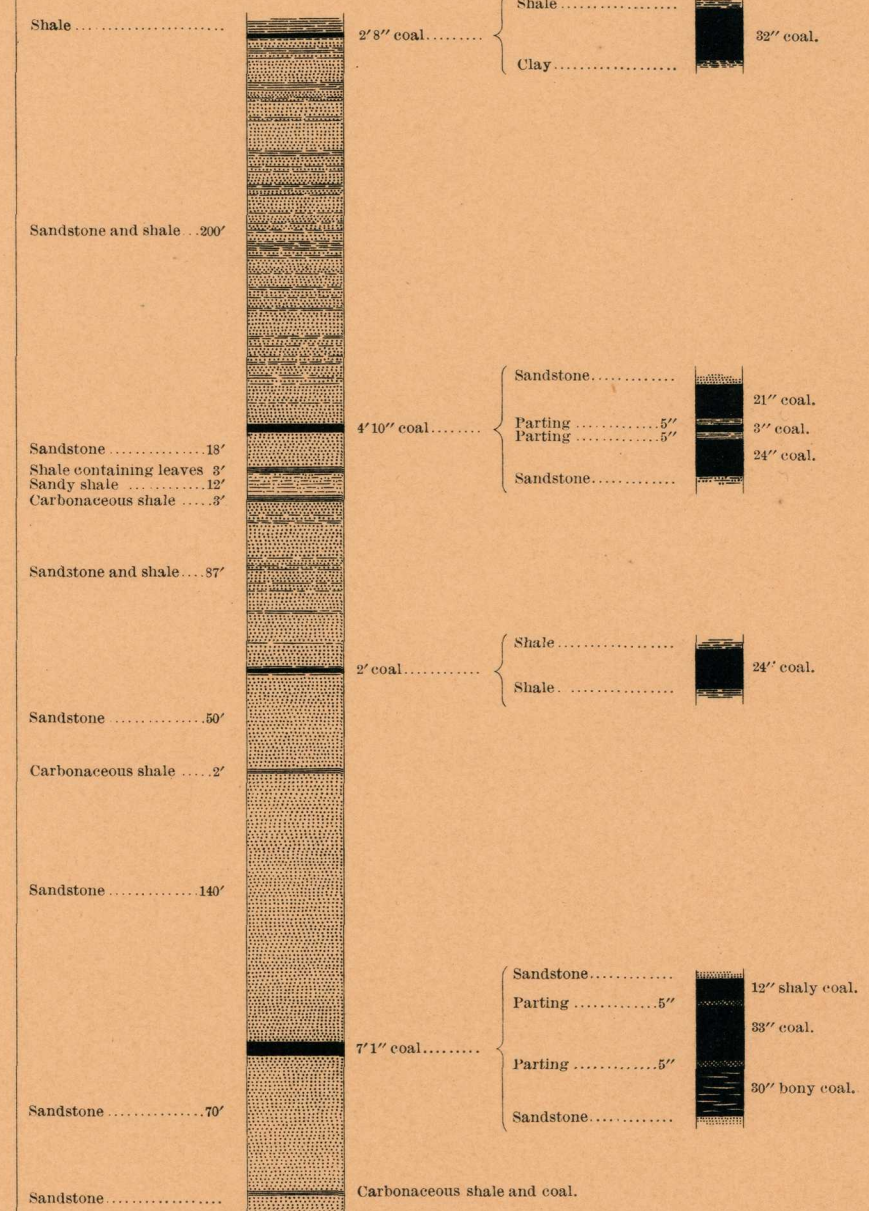


FIG. 11.—SECTION OF HARDY AND STEVA COALS NEAR GLASGOW.

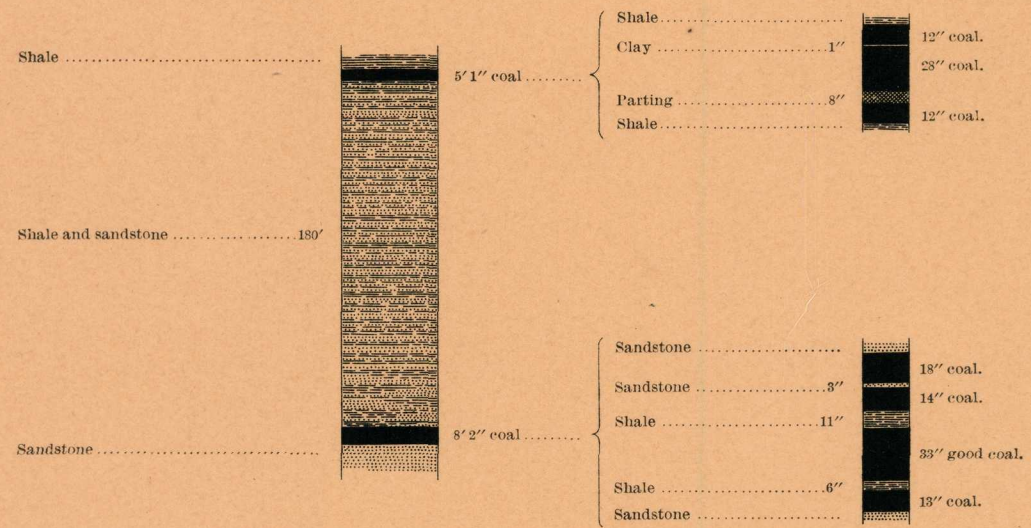


FIG. 12.—SECTION OF COAL-BEARING ROCKS 2 1/2 MILES NORTHEAST OF COALEDO, NEAR LINE BETWEEN SECS. 12 AND 13, T. 27 S., R. 13 W.

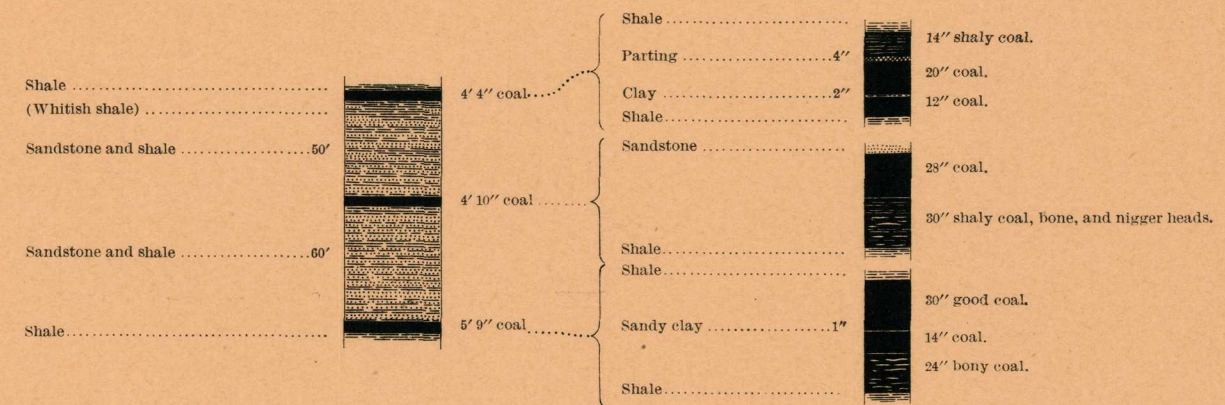


FIG. 13.—SECTION OF COAL-BEARING ROCKS IN FATELK CREEK REGION.

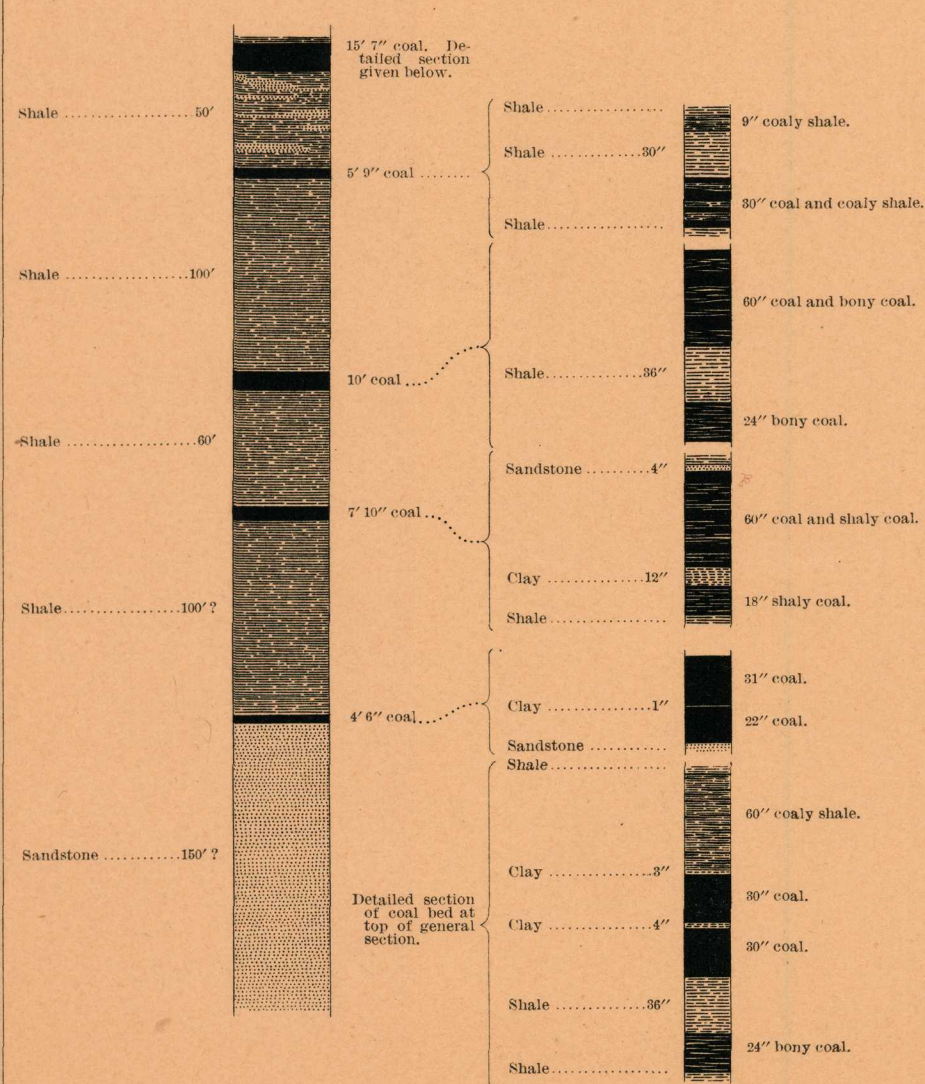


FIG. 14.—SECTION OF COAL-BEARING ROCKS NEAR WESTERN EDGE OF SEC. 19, T. 27 S., R. 13 W.

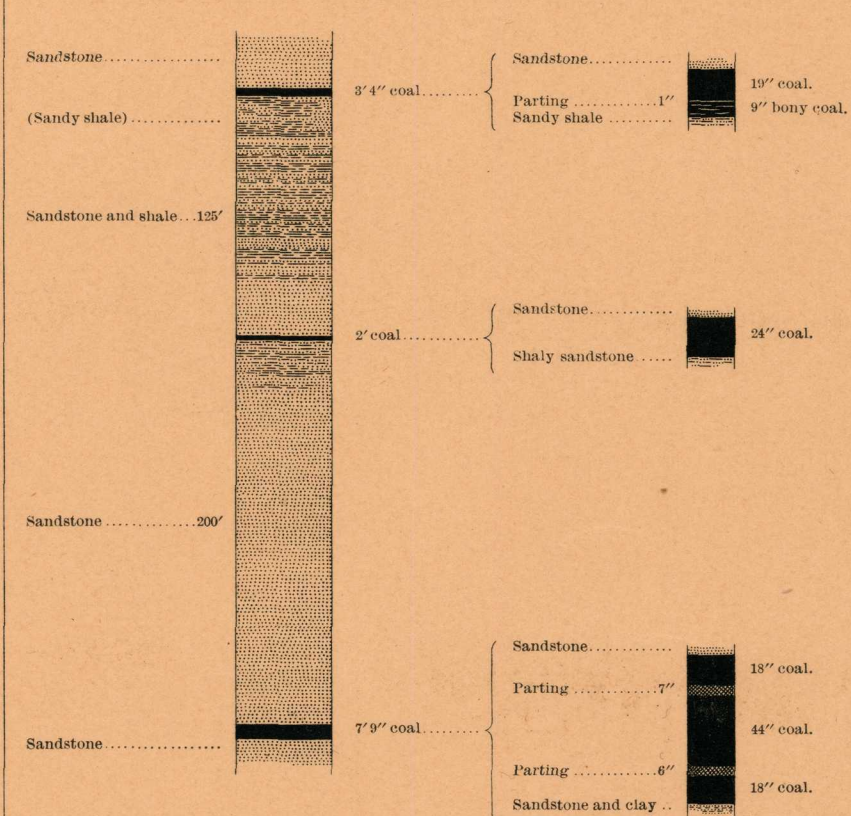
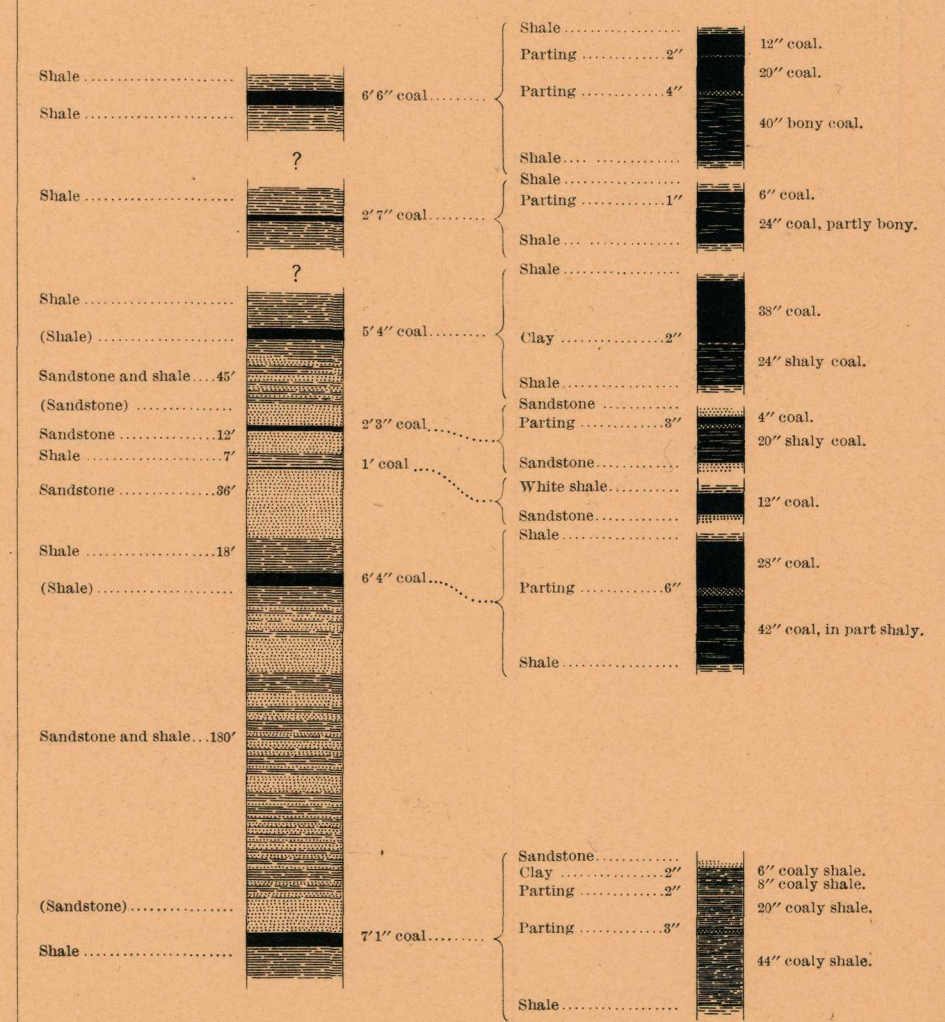


FIG. 15.—SECTION OF COAL-BEARING ROCKS AT BEAVER CREEK MINE (UTTER MINES) THREE-FOURTHS OF A MILE SOUTHEAST OF COALEDO.



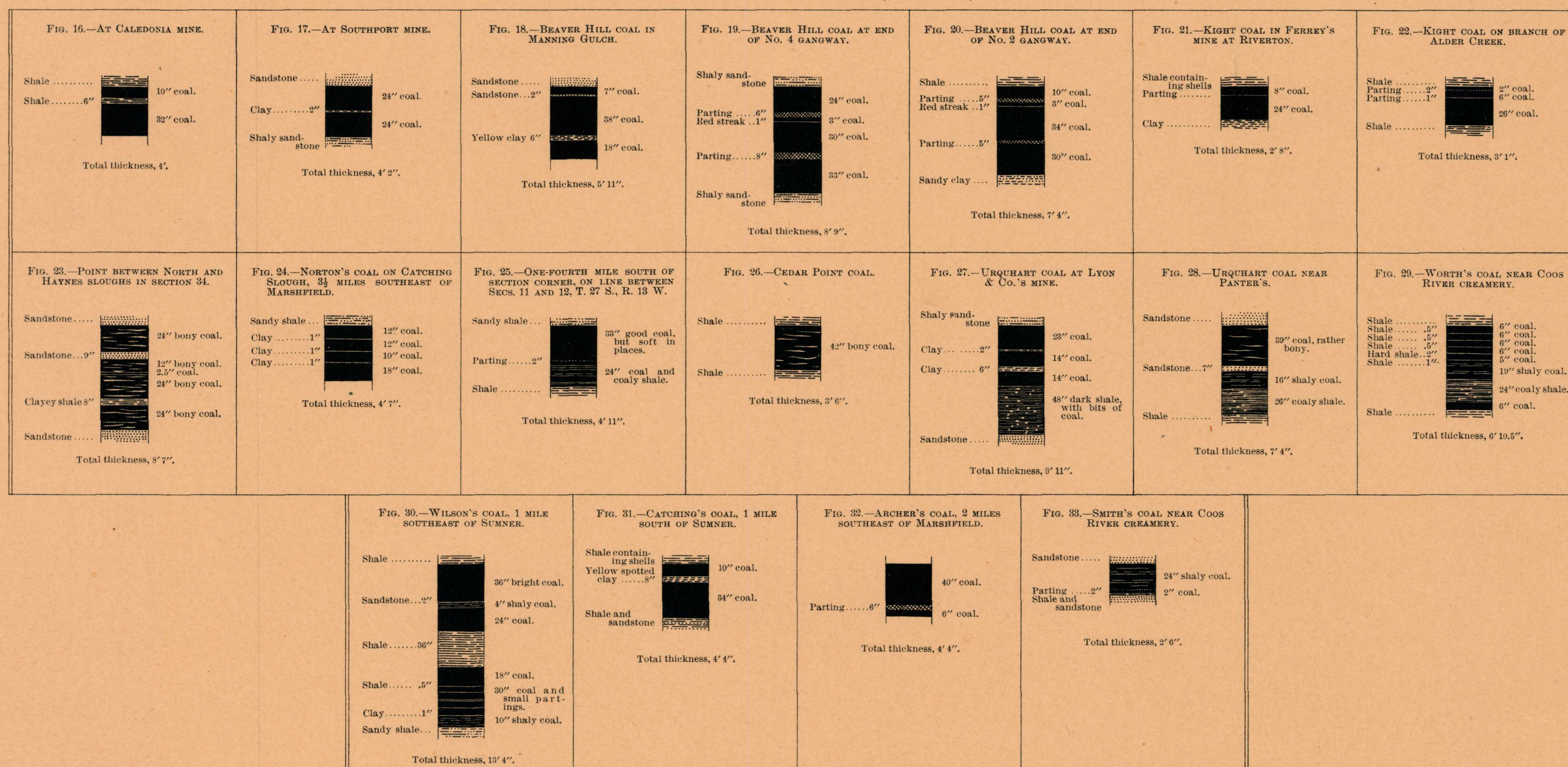

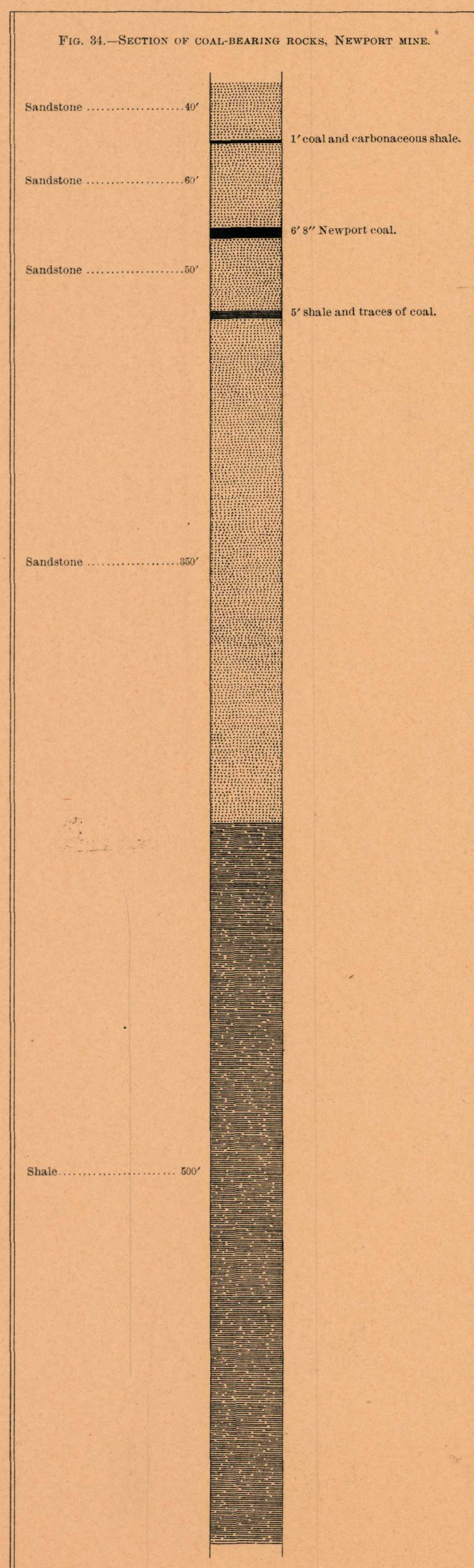

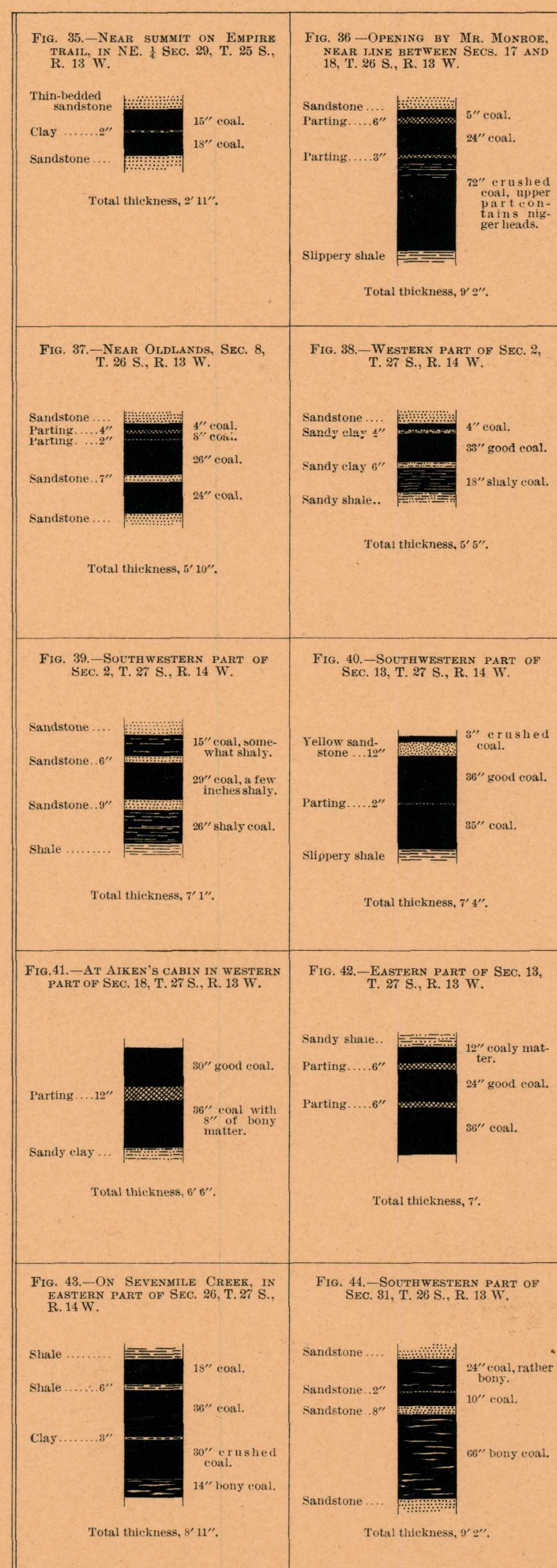

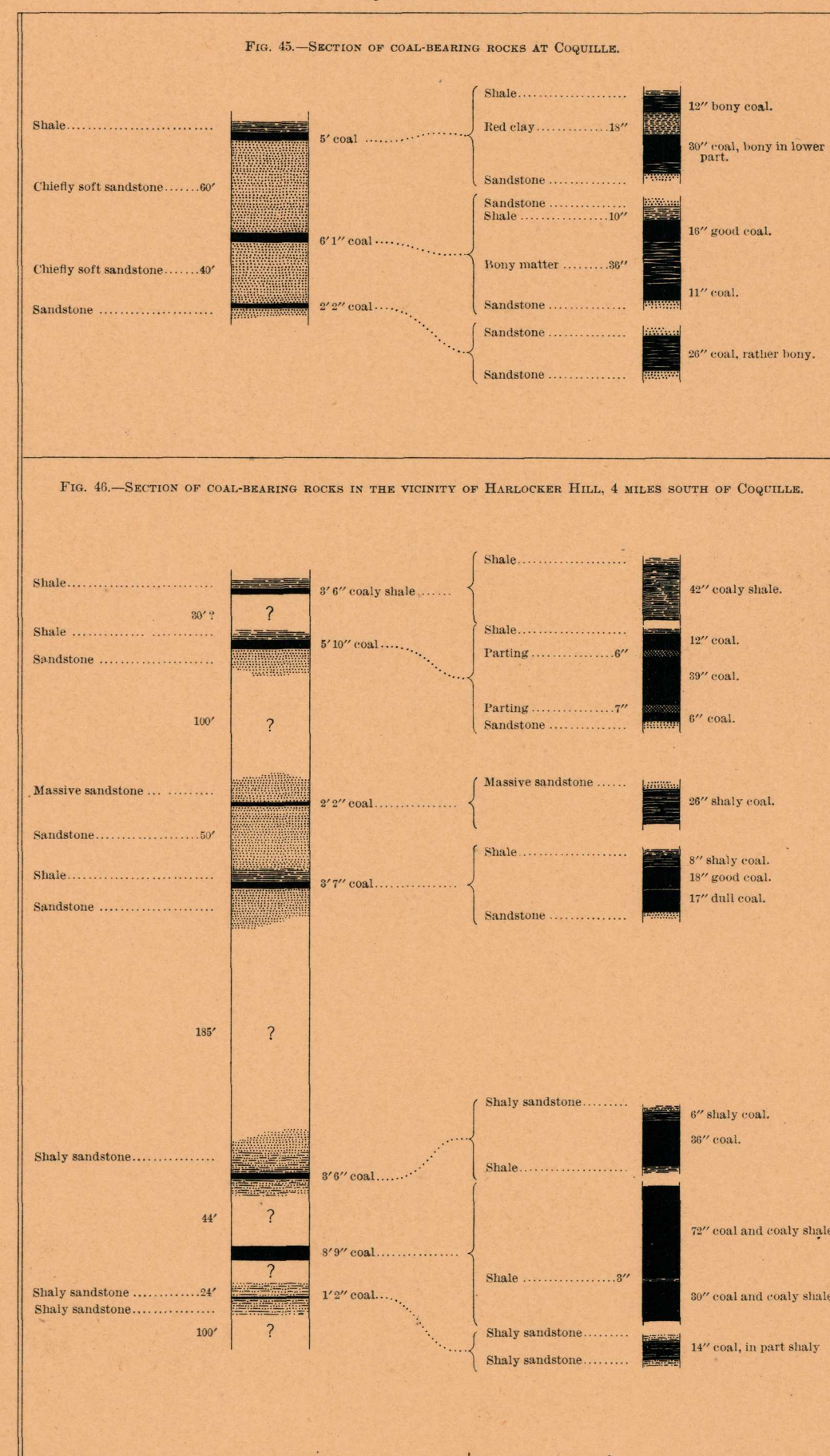
NEWPORT BASIN.
