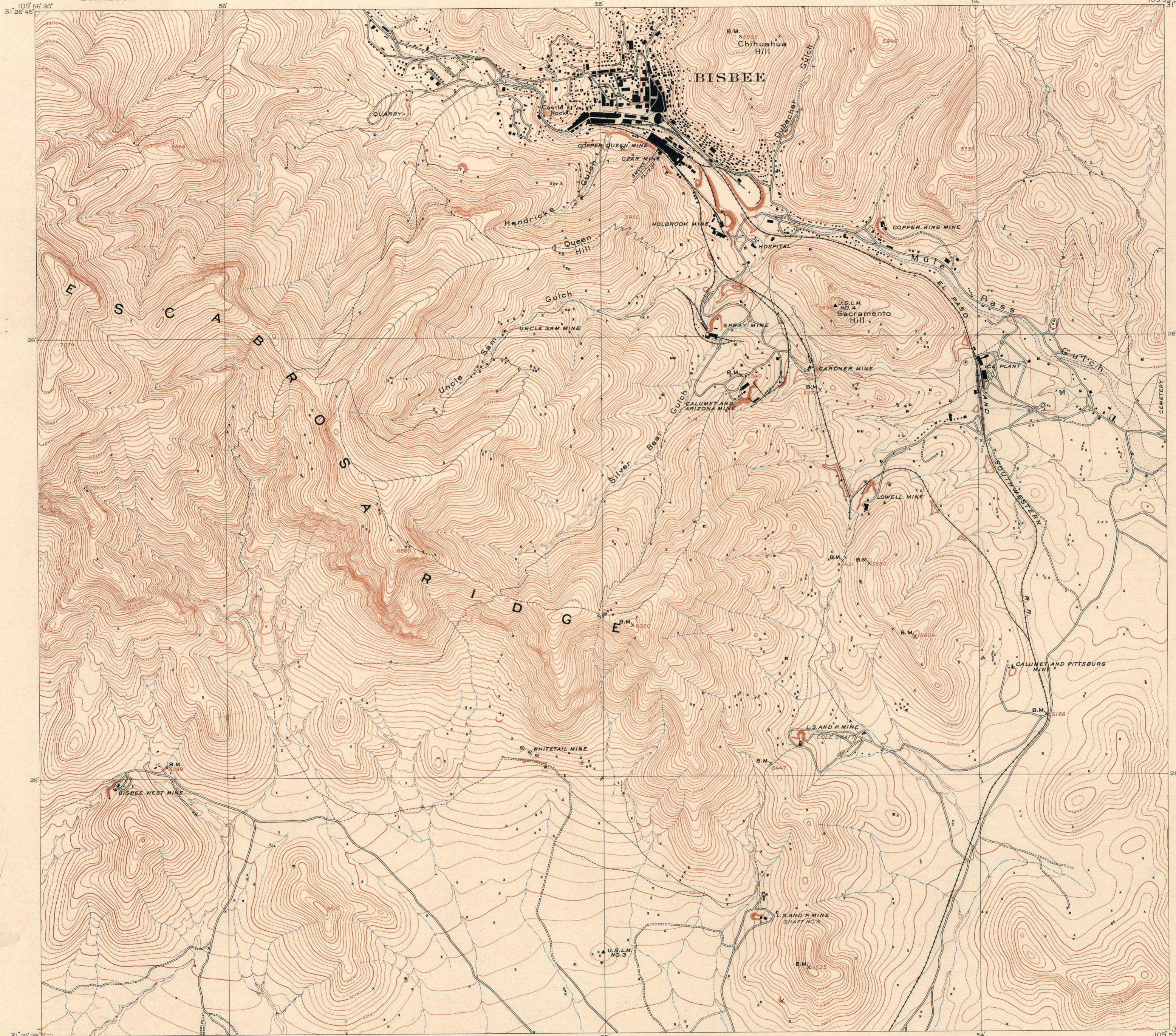

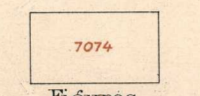

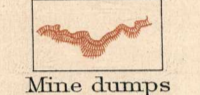

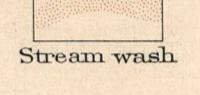
Contours

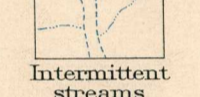
