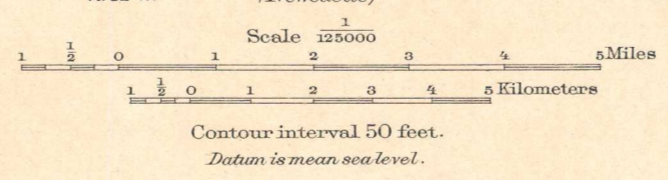
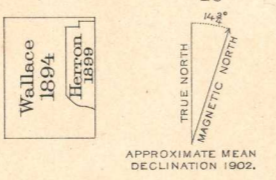


DIAGRAM OF TOWNSHIP
