

The eruption on Paoha Island in Mono Lake in east-central California occurred sometime between A.D. 1720 and 1850. This is the most recent eruption within the Long Valley Volcanic Center. The area is monitored by the Long Valley Observatory (LVO), one of five USGS Volcano Hazards Program observatories that monitor U.S. volcanoes for science and public safety.
