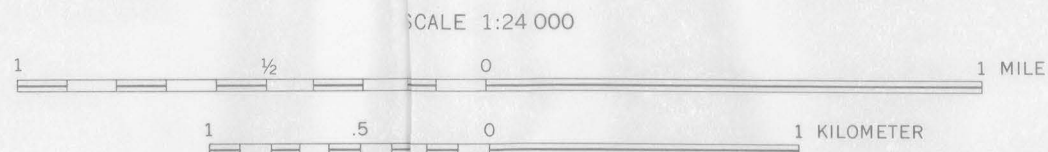
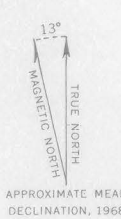
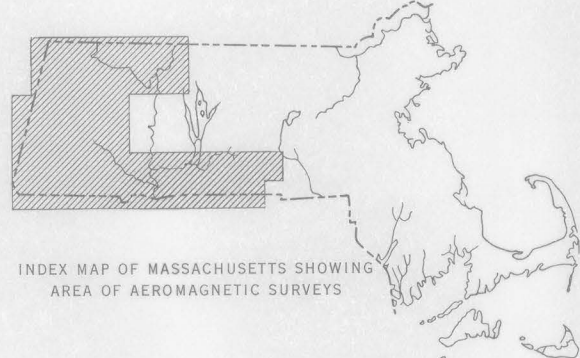

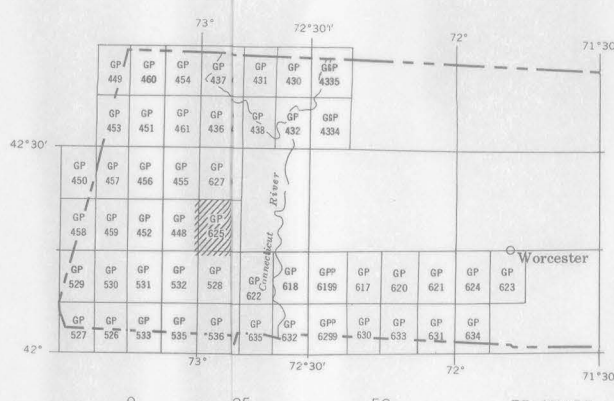

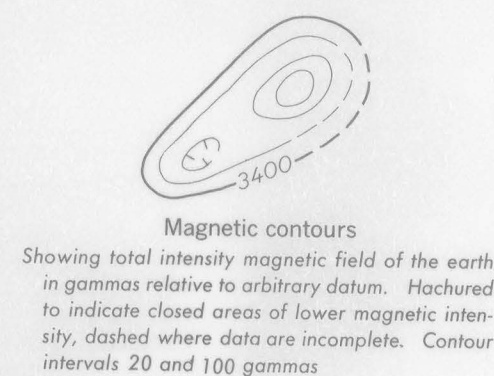


INDEX MAP OF MASSACHUSETTS SHOWING AREA OF AEROMAGNETIC SURVEYS
