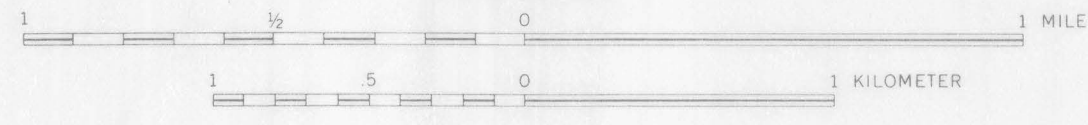
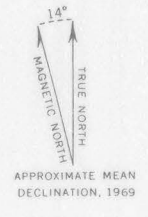

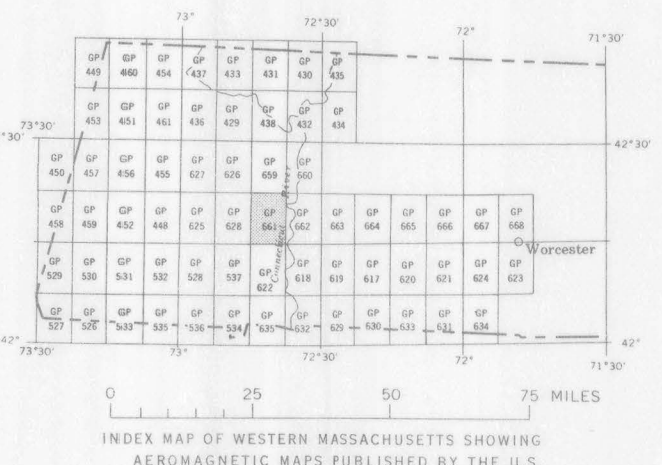
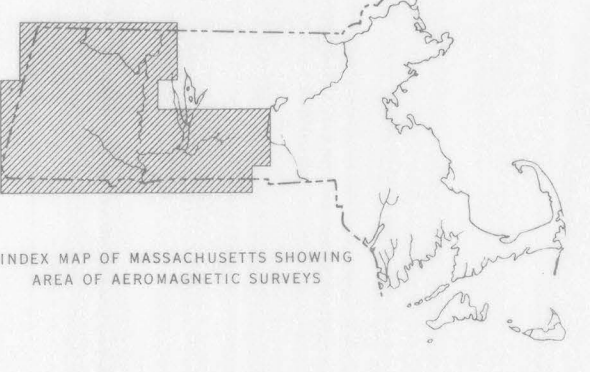

EXPLANATION

Showing total intensity magnetic field of the earth in gammas relative to arbitrary datum. Hooked to indicate closed areas of lower magnetic intensity, dashed where data are incomplete. Contour interval 20 gammas
- Location of measured maximum or minimum intensity within closed high or closed low
- Flight path
