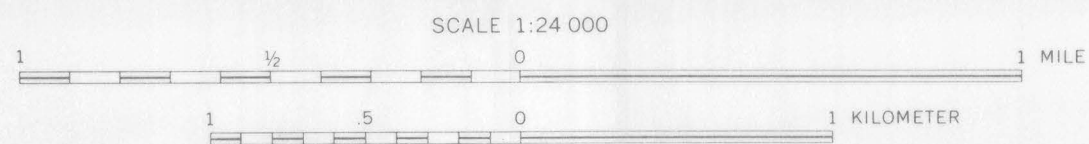

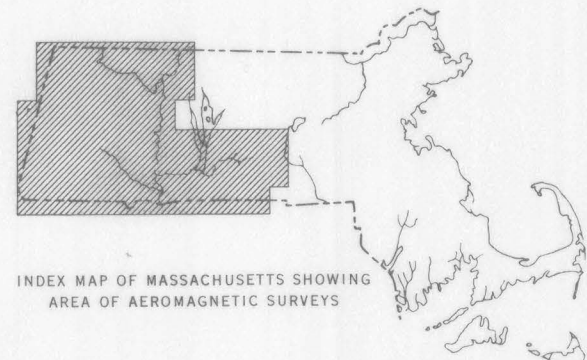


Magnetic contours

intervals 20 and 100 gammas

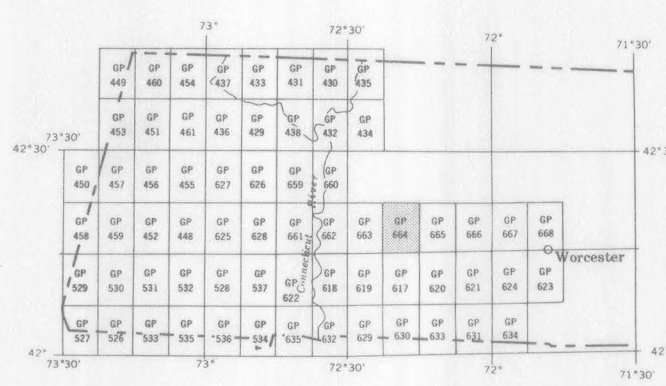
Location of measured maximum or minimum
