

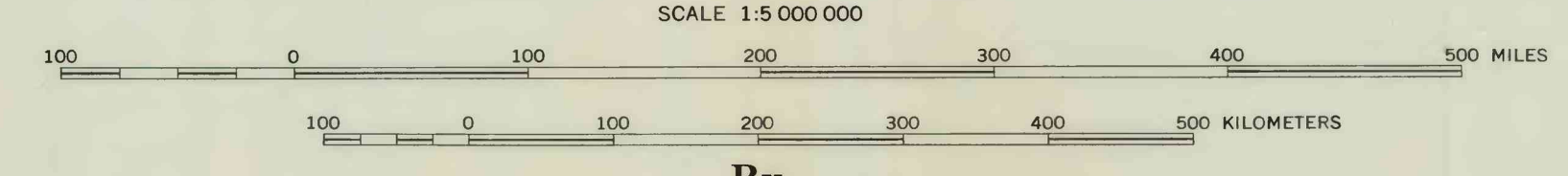
EXPLANATION

Number of days surface-water temperatures within 32°-34° Fahrenheit

- 101 or more
- 51-100
- 11-50
- 1-10
- 0

Note: The 32°-34° F range was selected because the thermograph is always near the bottom of the stream. When the water temperature at the bottom of a stream is 34° F, the surface temperature of the stream is often 32° F.
