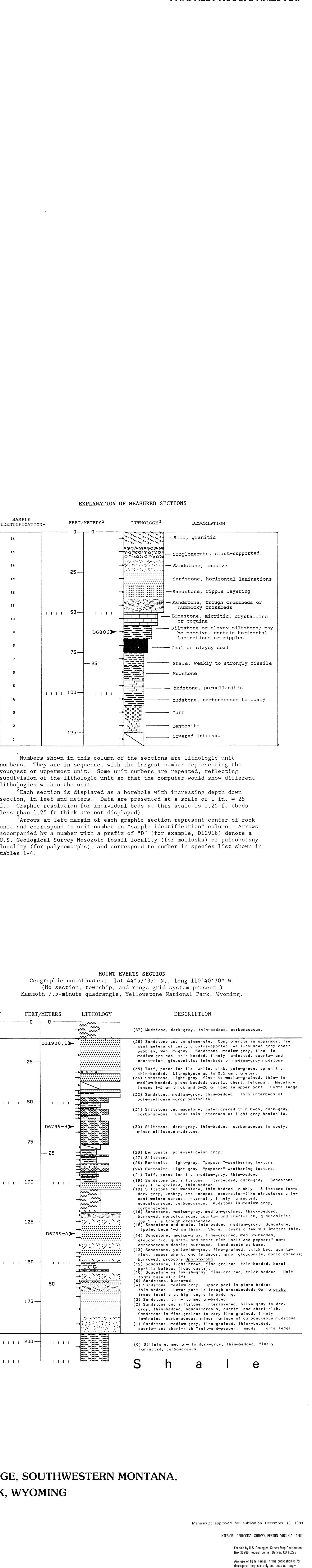
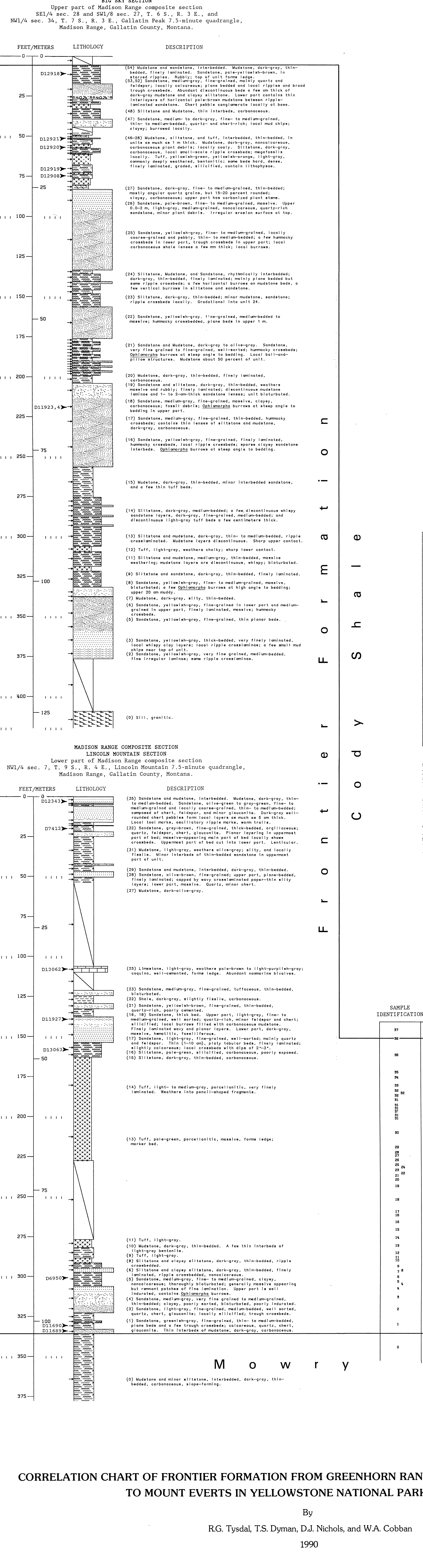
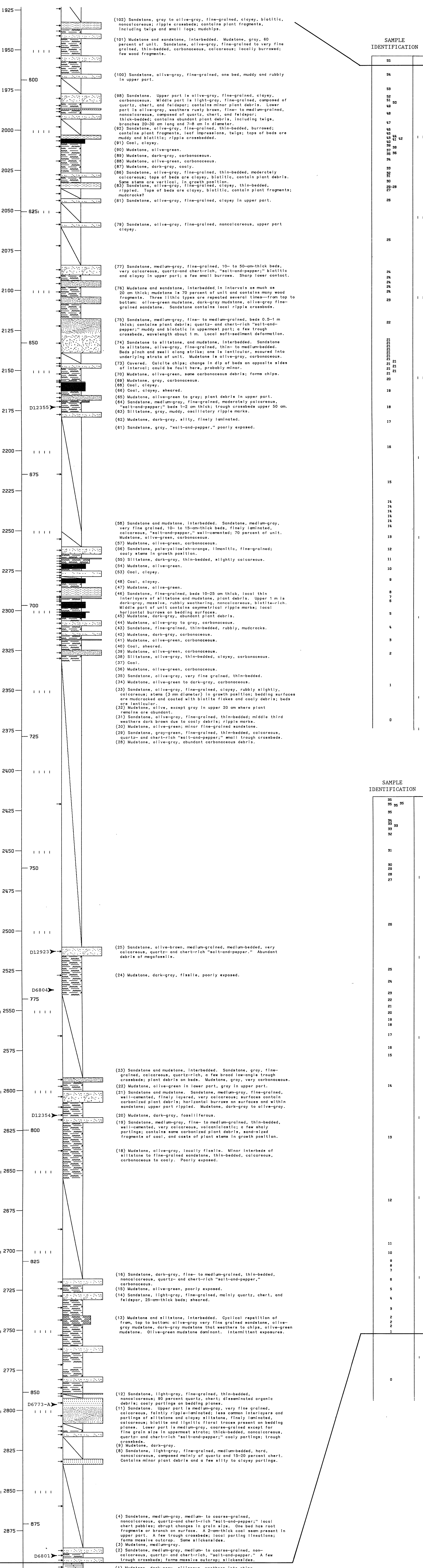
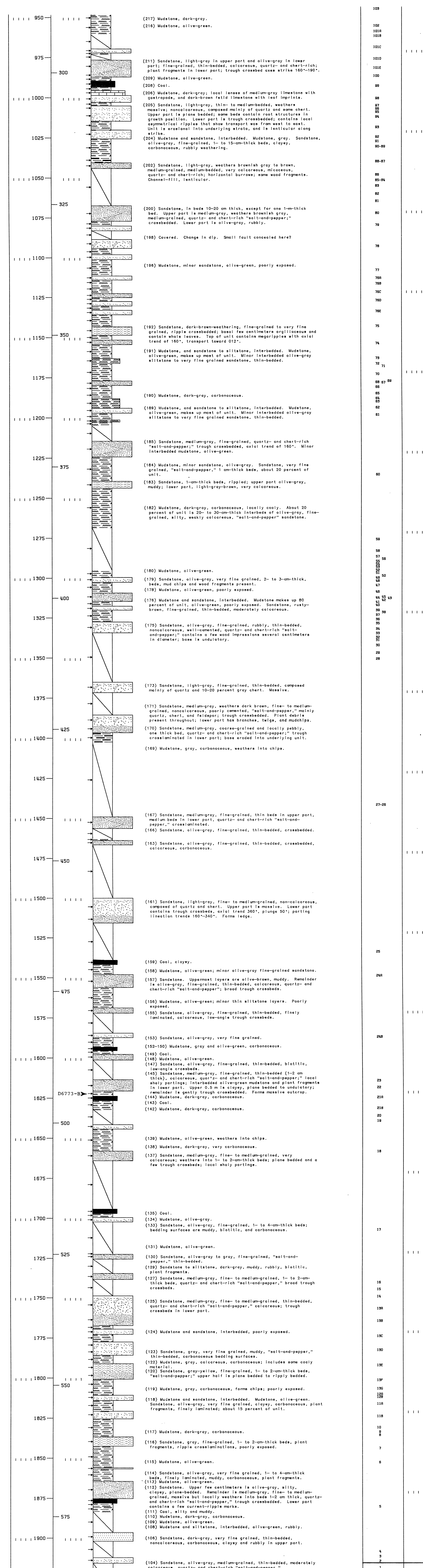
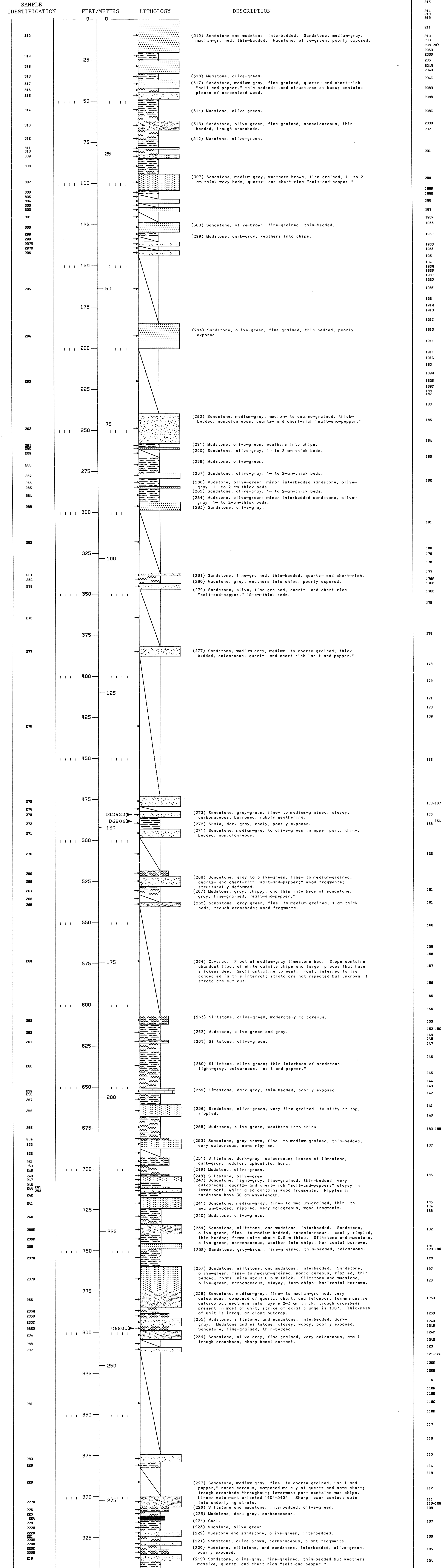

Some unit numbers are repeated, reflecting subdivision of the lithologic unit so that the computer would show different lithologies within the unit.
