

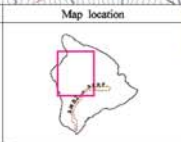

Projection used: 10,000 meter grid, zone 5, Universal Transverse Mercator. International adopted 20,000 foot grid scale based on Hawaii coordinate system, Zone 5. Call Hawaiian names.

There may be private buildings within the boundaries of the National or State Reservations shown on the map.
