

This CD-ROM contains images of Proceedings from the Federal Interagency Sedimentation Conferences of 1947, 1963, 1976, 1986, 1991, 1996, 2001, and 2006.

The first Joint Federal Interagency Conference (JFIC 2006) convened the 3rd Federal Interagency Hydrologic Modeling Conference (3rdFIHMC) and the 8th Federal Interagency Sedimentation Conference (8thFISC). The 8thFISC Proceedings are included on this CD, as well as for FISCs 1 through 7.

How to use this CD-ROM: This CD-ROM uses Acrobat Reader, free from Adobe.com <Step 1> Launch your Adobe Acrobat Reader.

<Step 2> Open the file, "MENU.pdf"

Use the Reader functions to read, copy, print, and search the 7500+ pages of Proceedings. The "Search" capability is realized if your Adobe Acrobat Reader software was downloaded with this feature. Use the bookmarks on the left to navigate where you want to go throughout the proceedings. *The "Pointing Hand" cursor indicates an active link to contents and papers*.

A Note About These PDF Files: Some of these files are facsimiles of the original printed pages of the Proceedings. Text is selectively copiable and globally searchable. For Proceedings 1 - 6, scanned gray-scale photos are generally of poorer quality than the originals due to the original print quality. The 7th and 8th FISC proceedings were prepared from digital files and are of excellent quality.

Files on this CD-ROM are in Adobe Portable Document Format (PDF) and are read and printed using the free Adobe Acrobat Reader, available as a free download from http://www.adobe.com.
