## THE MINERAL INDUSTRY OF FRENCH GUIANA

In 2016, the production of mineral commodities—notably cement, gold, laterite, sand (common), and stone (crushed)—represented only a minor part of the economy of French Guiana (Institut d'Emission des Départements d'Outre-Mer, 2016, p. 81–82; 2017, p. 50, 76–77, 87). The legislative framework for the mineral sector in French Guiana is provided by Act No. 98–297 of 1998. The Schéma Départemental d'Orientation Minière [Regional Framework for the Mining Sector] was approved in 2011 by Decree No. 2011–2105 and entered into force on January 1, 2012. Data on mineral production are in table 1. Table 2 is a list of major mineral industry facilities. More-extensive coverage of the mineral industry of French Guiana can be found in previous editions
