THE MINERAL INDUSTRY OF SOMALIA

In 2016, the production of mineral commodities—notably granite, marble, and sandstone—represented only a minor part of the economy of Somalia (table 1; International Monetary Fund, 2017, p. 7, 34, 38; International Trade Center, 2017, p. 10, 14). Regional and local governing bodies, including the self-declared Republic of Somaliland in northwestern Somalia, the semiautonomous Federated Member State Government of Puntland in northeastern and south-central Somalia, and the internationally recognized Federal Government of Somalia (Mogadishu) controlled the combined areas of country. The legislative framework for the mineral sector in Somalia is provided by Articles 43, 44, and 54 of the Provisional Constitution of the Federal Republic of Somalia adopted in 2012. Table 1 is a list of major mineral industry facilities.
