THE MINERAL INDUSTRY OF SOUTH SUDAN

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In 2016, the economy of South Sudan was based largely on the production of crude petroleum (U.S. Central Intelligence Agency, 2017). The legislative framework for the mineral sector in South Sudan is provided by Mining Act No. 36 of 2012, and Petroleum Act of 2012. Data on mineral production are in table 1. Table 2 is a list of major mineral industry facilities. More-extensive coverage of the mineral industry of South Sudan can be found in previous editions of the U.S. Geological Survey Minerals
