## THE MINERAL INDUSTRY OF TAIWAN

In 2017 and 2018, the production of mineral commodities—notably dolomite, iron and steel, refined lead, marble, natural gas, serpentine, and industrial sand and gravel—represented only a minor part of the economy of Taiwan (Bureau of Mines, 2019, p. 18). The legislative framework for the mineral sector in Taiwan is provided by the Mining Act of 1930 and its amendments in 2003. Data on mineral production are in table 1. Table 2 is a list of major mineral industry facilities. More-extensive coverage of the mineral industry of Taiwan

can be found in previous editions of the U.S. Geological Survey Minerals Yearbook, volume III, Area Reports—International—Asia and the Pacific, which are available at https://www.usgs.gov/centers/nmic/asia-and-pacific.
