### THE MINERAL INDUSTRY OF DJIBOUTI

In 2019, the production of mineral commodities—notably cement, clay, salt, and sand and gravel—represented only a minor part of the economy of Djibouti (Banque Centrale de Djibouti, undated, p. 22). The legislative framework for the mineral sector in Djibouti is provided by law No. L 138, SB, 16, 7th of July 23, 2016, and law No. 117/AN/05 of October 16, 2005. Data on mineral production are in table 1. Table 2 is a list of major mineral industry facilities. More-extensive coverage of the mineral industry of Djibouti
