(Yellowish brown and yellowish gray earthy limestone; solid color indicates rock
in place, ruled pattern indicates landside rubble mantling all formations
below the limestone members)



Chinle formation
(Bluish gray marl, and purplish gray shale with a few
thin sandstone members)



Shinerump conglomerate
(White and light buff sandstone and conglomerate, in part earthy)



Moenkopi formation

(Maroon shale enclosing lenticular beds of maroon earthy sandstone
and light gray medium-grained sandstone; broken lines indicate
outcrops of tops of conspicuous sandstone members)
