Idealized vertical section to show approximate elevations of lower levels and sub-levels, Champion Mine. Datum is level of Lake Superior, about 600 feet above mean sea level. Assumed dip of Baltic Lode 69° N W.

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Vertical section showing levels 40, 42, 44, 46, 48, 50, 52, 54, 56, 58, 60, 62, 64, 66, 68, 70, 72, 74, 76, 78, 80, 82, 84, 86, 88, 90, 92, 94, 96, 98, 100.

Note: Lodes repeated in lower levels by nearly longitudinal. 48' Fault lodes on hanging wall side of fault (N.W. side) are called "hanging panel" -HP, and lodes on foot wall side "foot panel" -FP.
