



Foreign boulders larger than 5 feet in diameter (probably glacial erratics)

Concentration of foreign boulders larger than 5 feet in diameter (too dense to be counted and plotted individually)

Concentration of foreign boulders in bed of Moody Creek and of Lignite Creek (Number of boulders per mile of projection line at base of graph. Number beneath curve is total number of boulders)

Inferred contours on floor of the Nenana River valley during the Browne glaciation (long dashes where close topographic control exists; short dashes where close topographic control does not exist. Contour interval 250 feet)
