



Widely spaced patterns represent areas of presumed distribution of formations.

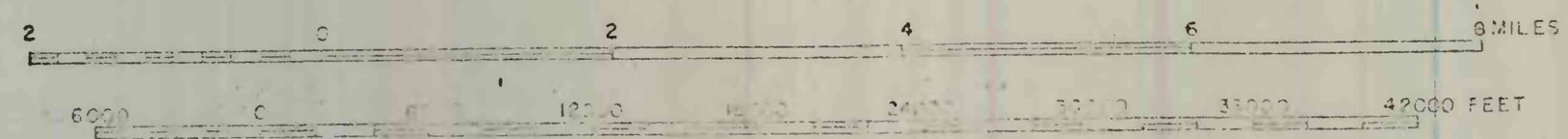
