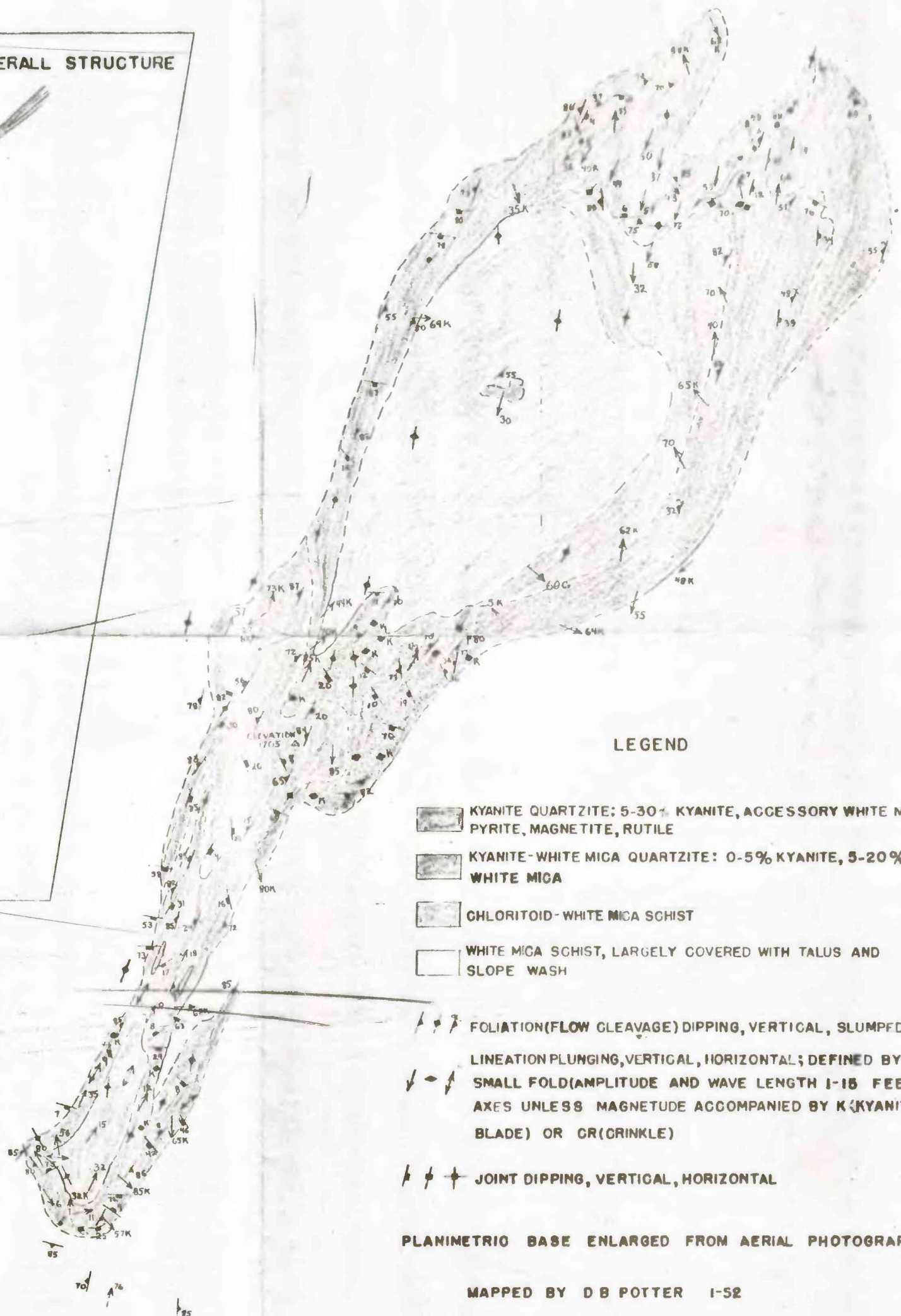
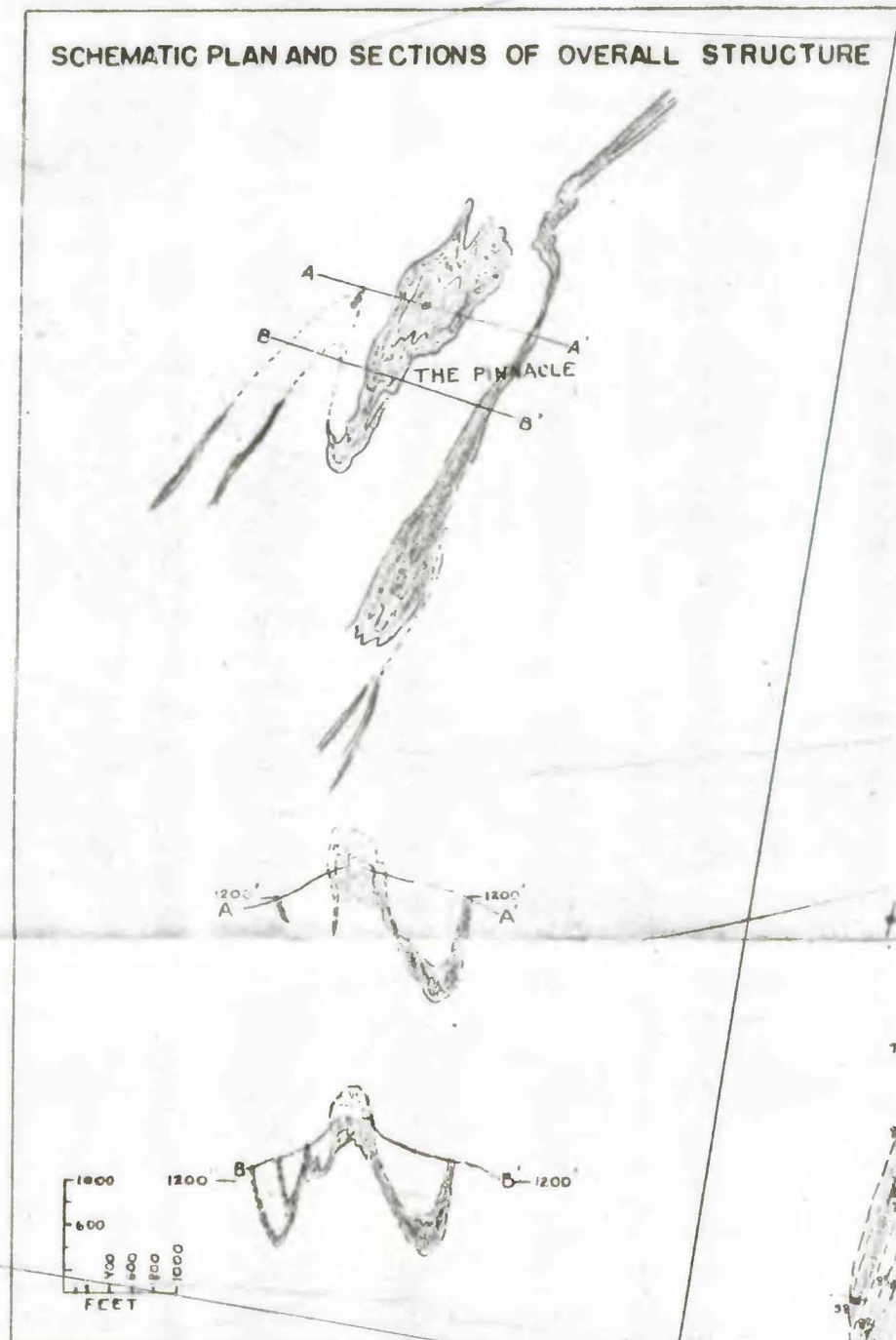

- CHLORITOID-WHITE MICA SCHIST
- WHITE MICA SCHIST, LARGELY COVERED WITH TALUS AND SLOPE WASH
- FOLIATION (FLOW CLEAVAGE) DIPPING, VERTICAL, SLUMPED
- LINEATION PLUNGING, VERTICAL, HORIZONTAL; DEFINED BY SMALL FOLD (AMPLITUDE AND WAVE LENGTH 1-15 FEET) AXES UNLESS MAGNITUDE ACCOMPANIED BY K (KYANITE BLADE) OR CR (CRINKLE)
