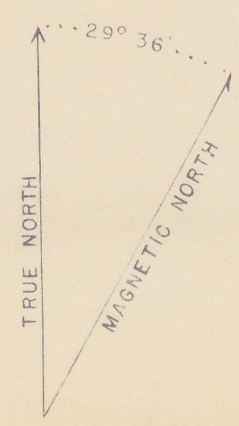


EXPLANATION

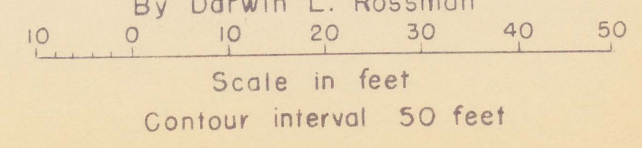
- Recrystallized rock (Probably sedimentary)
