


EXPLANATION

Qsg, predominant-ly gastropod shells; Qs, fine-grained quartz sand.




Brown mud

Qml, laminated, includes some black mud; Qmp, pelletal, mostly covered by mangrove which is omitted for clarity.




Gypsum




Sandstone

Very friable, contains shell bed, Qsh.




Core hole or test pit on line of section
