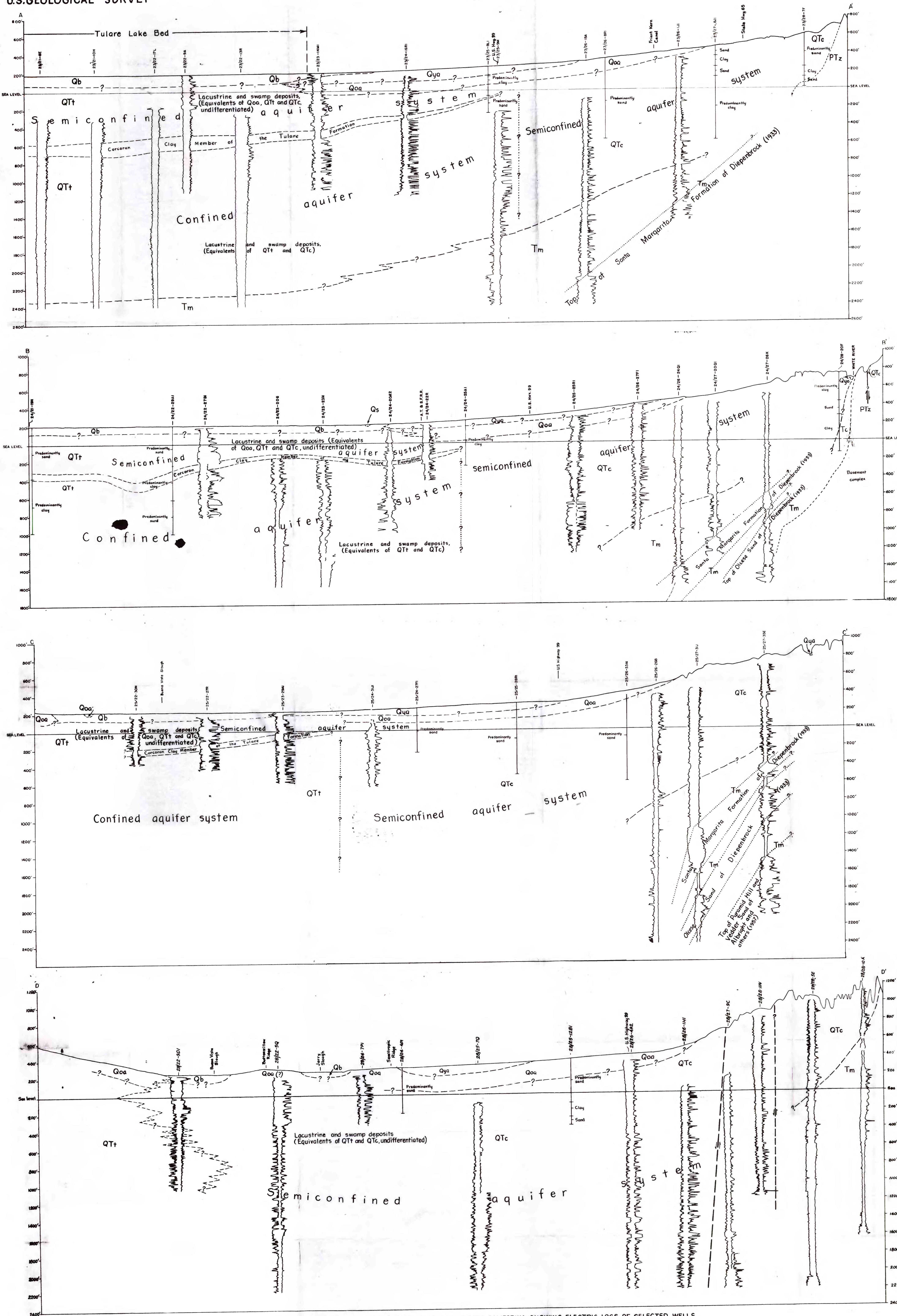


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EXPLANATION

- Qs: Dune sand
- Qya: Younger alluvium
- Qt: Terrace deposits
- Qoa: Older alluvium
- QTt: Tulare Formation
- Qyb: Flood-basin deposits
- QTc: Continental deposits, undifferentiated

Consolidated Rocks

- Tm: Marine rocks
- Tc: Nonmarine sedimentary rocks
- pTu: Basement complex

Arrows show direction of movement
Questioned where dip is unknown

Electric log of well
Left curve is self potential, right curve is resistivity

Boundary of semiconfined and confined aquifer systems
