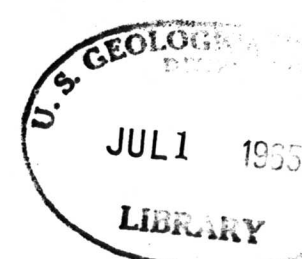

GEOLOGIC MAP AND CROSS SECTIONS OF THE NELCHINA AREA, SOUTH-CENTRAL ALASKA

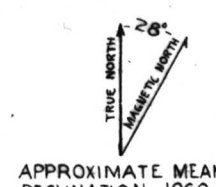
