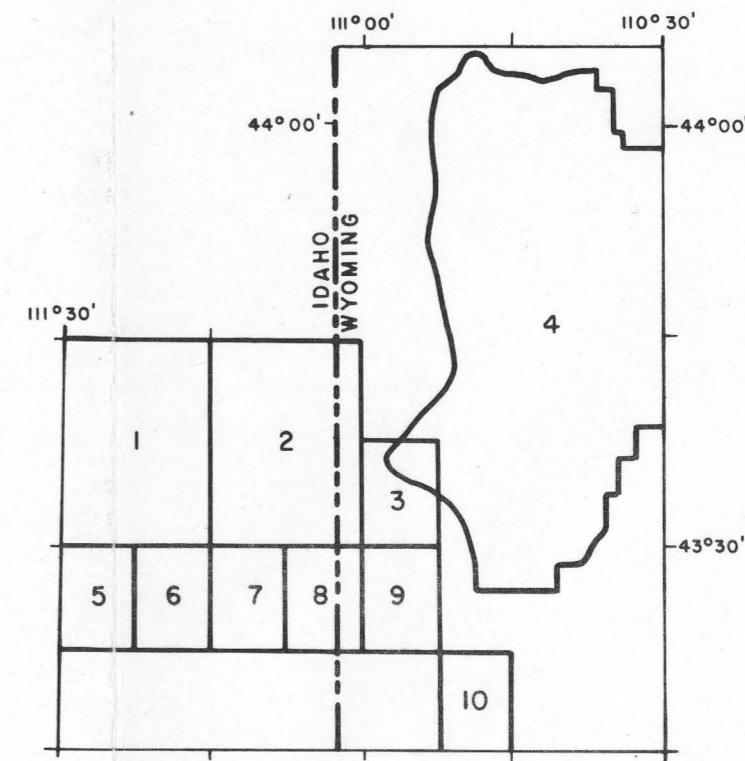
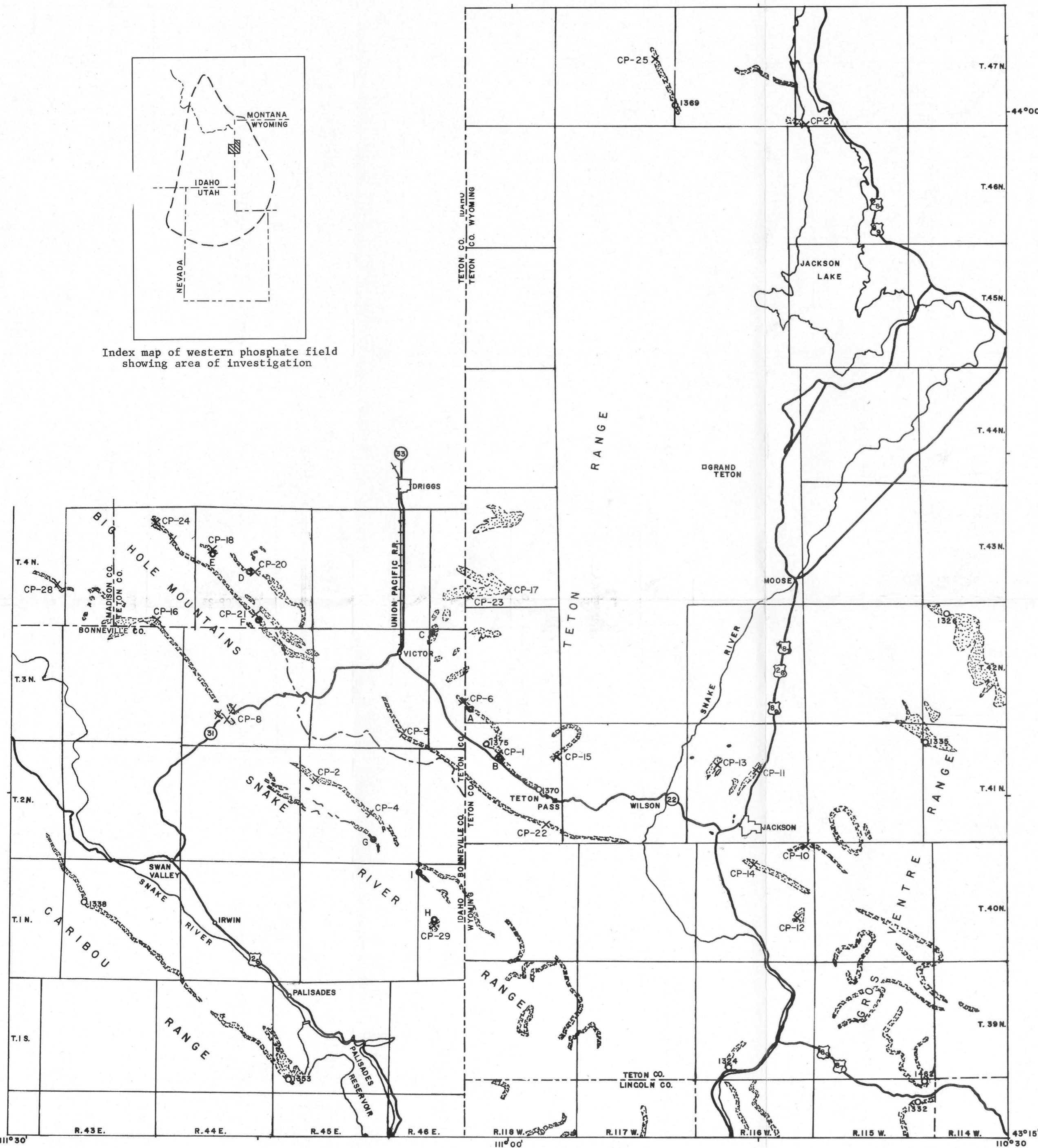


Index map of western phosphate field showing area of investigation
