
Maps showing locations of holes drilled in 1952 to 1954

Between May 5, 1952 and November 22, 1954 the U. S. Geological Survey diamond-drilled 505 holes totaling 123,371 feet in the La Sal Creek area. The exploration for uranium- and vanadium-bearing deposits was done on behalf of the Division of Raw Materials of the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission. All of the known uranium deposits in the area are in the Jurassic Morrison Formation, principally the Salt Wash Member, and are described in a published report ^{1/}.




FIGURE 1.--INDEX MAP OF PART OF THE COLORADO PLATEAU SHOWING THE LOCATION OF THE LA SAL CREEK AREA, PARADOX DISTRICT, MONTROSE COUNTY, COLORADO, AND SAN JUAN COUNTY, UTAH

The maps include an index map (fig. 1) and four others showing locations of drill holes (figs. 2, 3, 4, and 5). Logs of most of the holes identified on the accompanying maps may be inspected at the U. S. Geological Survey Library, Building 25, Federal Center, Denver, Colo. 80225, and at the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission Office, Grand Junction, Colo. 81501. Logs of nine holes on land withdrawn for use of the Atomic Energy Commission are on open file at the Commission's Grand Junction Office.
