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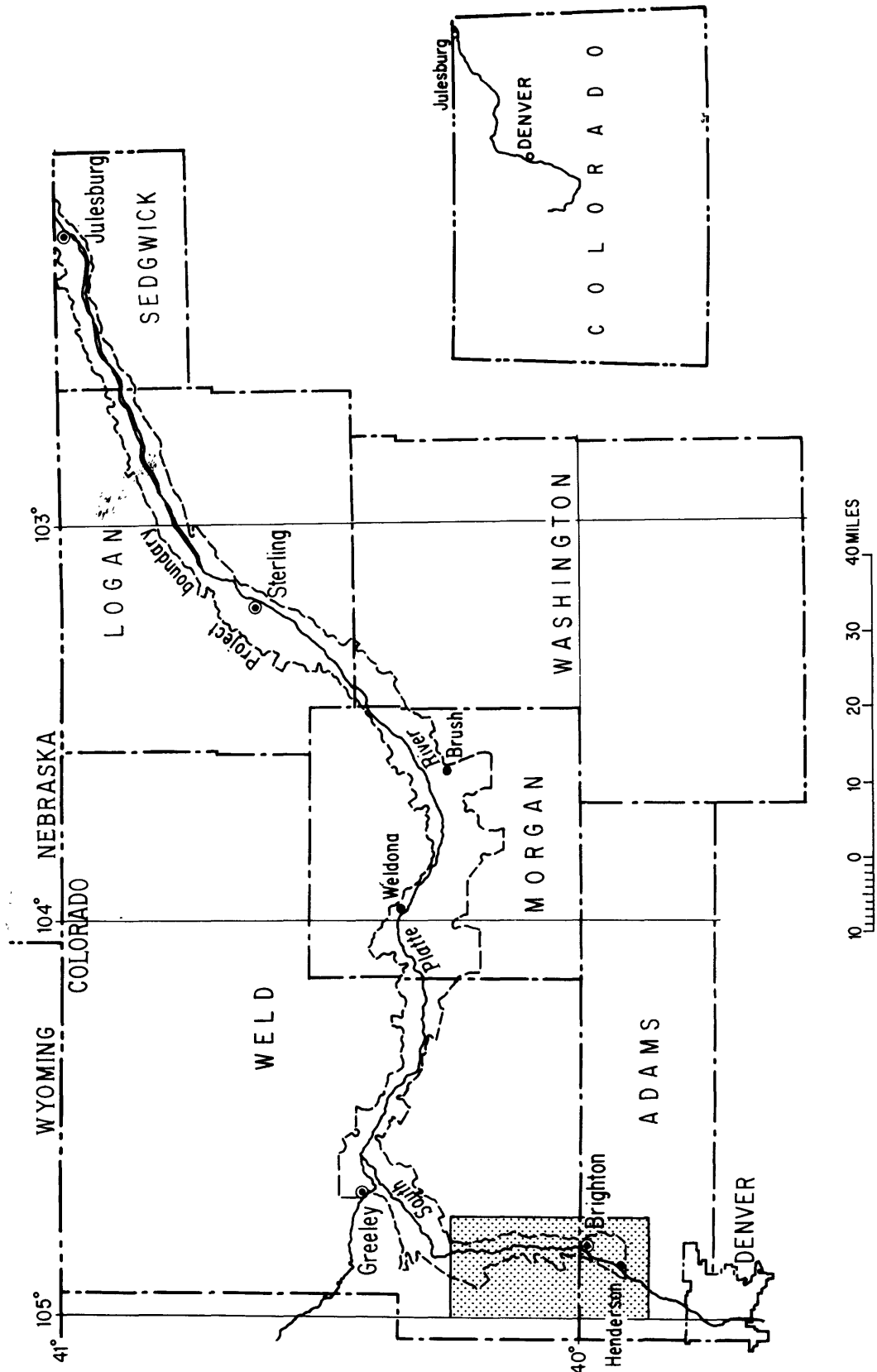


Figure 1. --Index map showing location of the Brighton reach (shaded area) of the South Platte River valley, Colorado.

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
