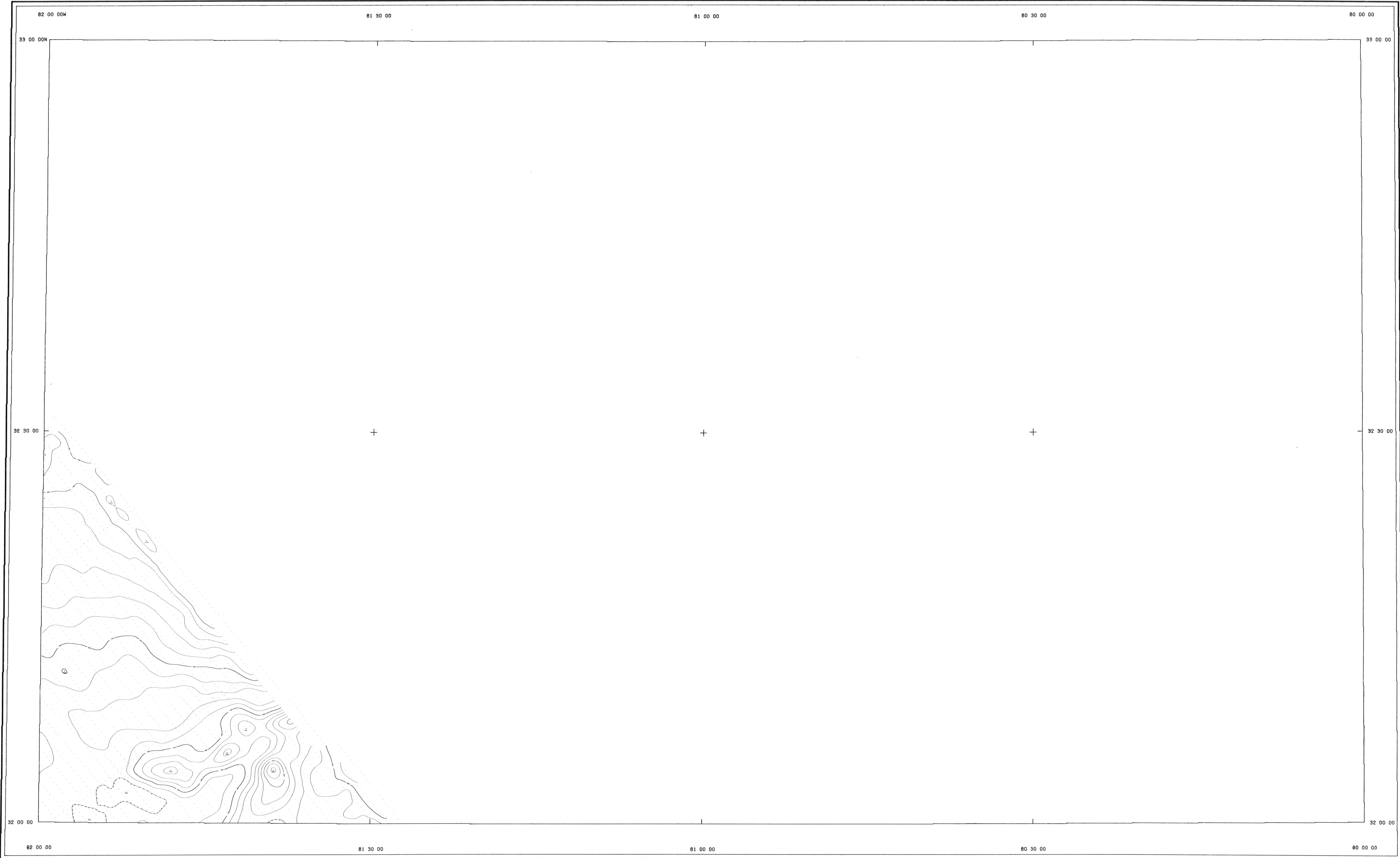

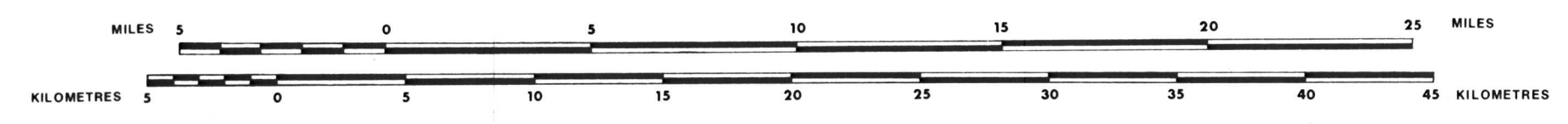
A REGIONAL TREND OF 8.49 GAMMAS/MILE NORTH
