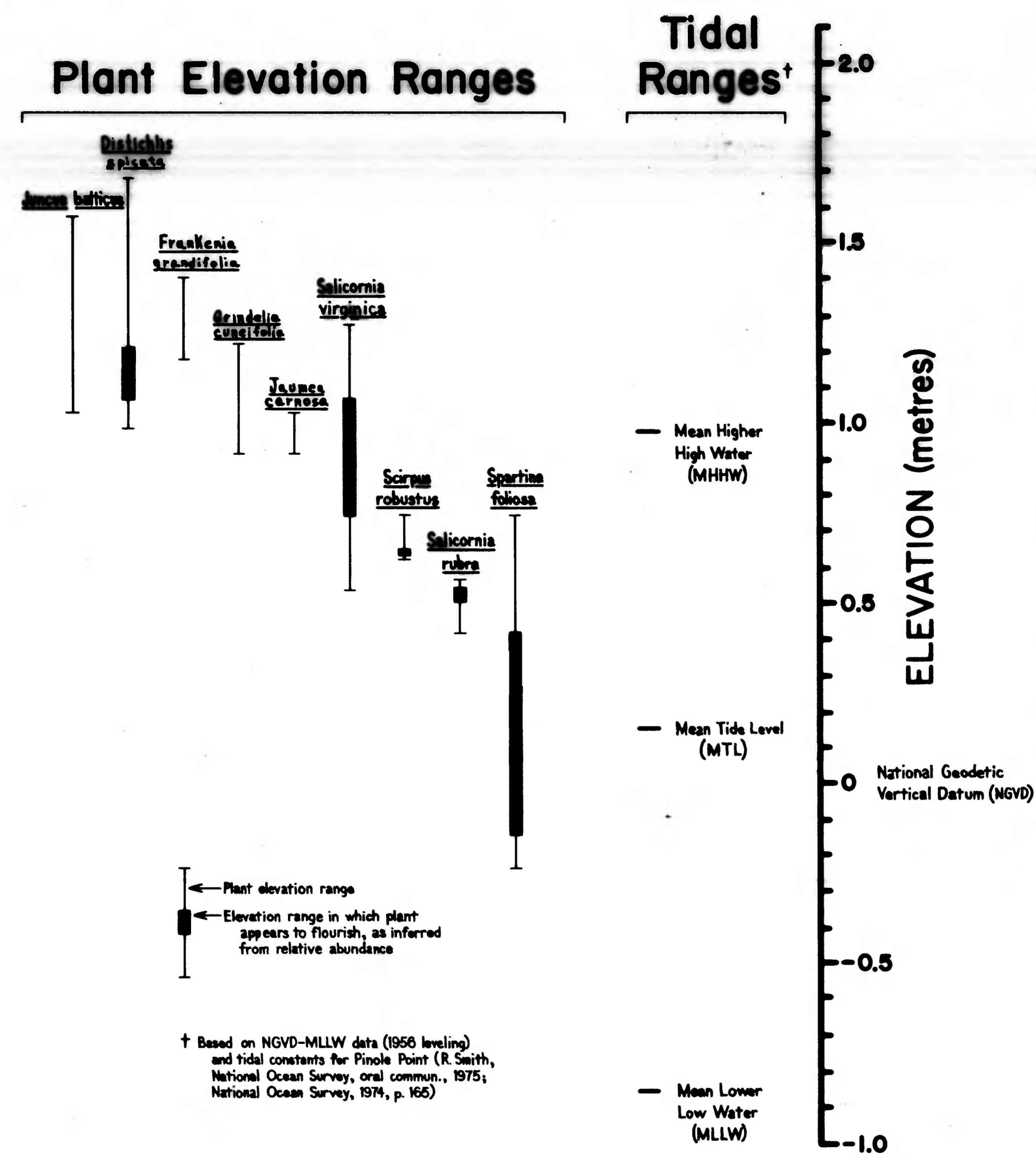
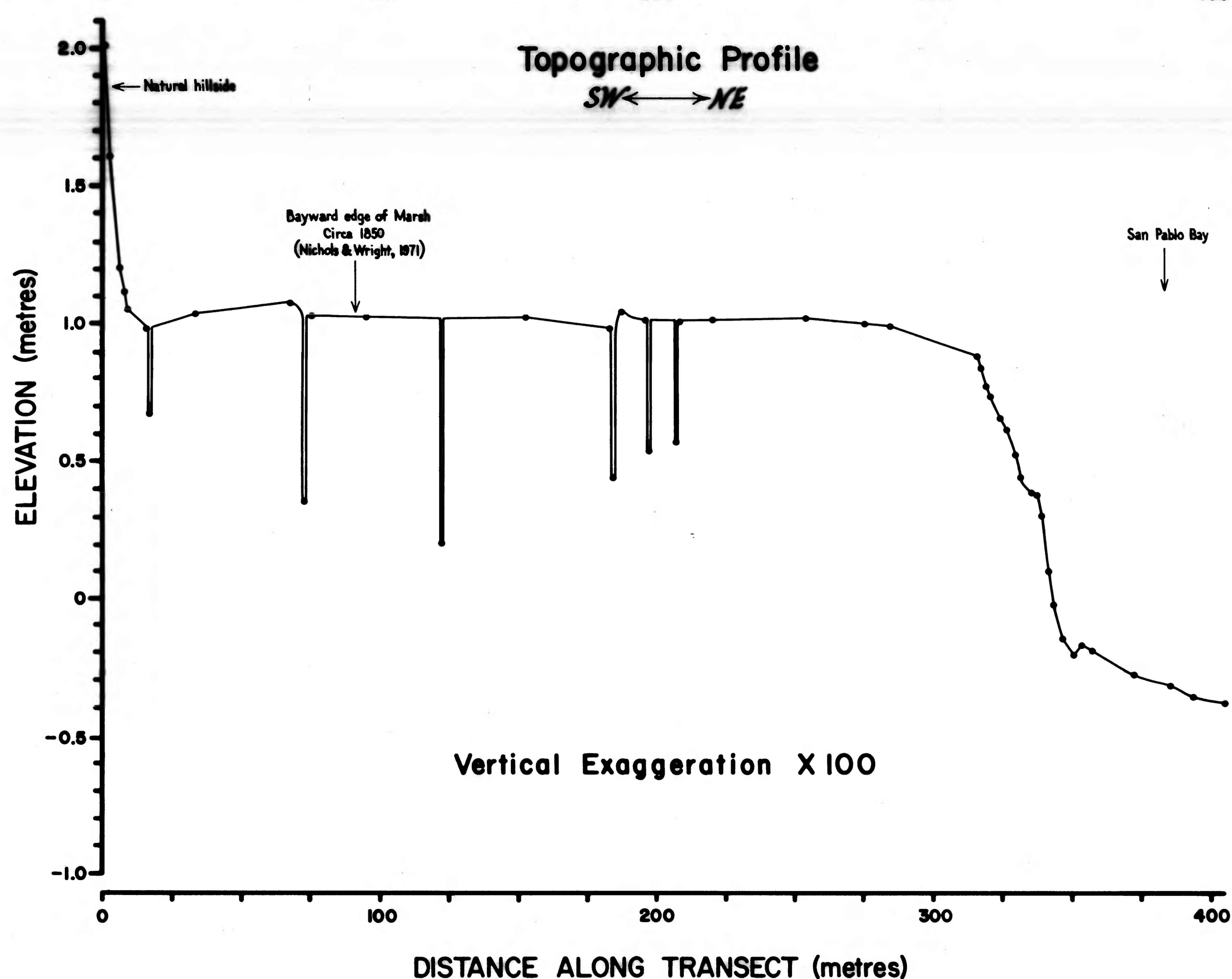
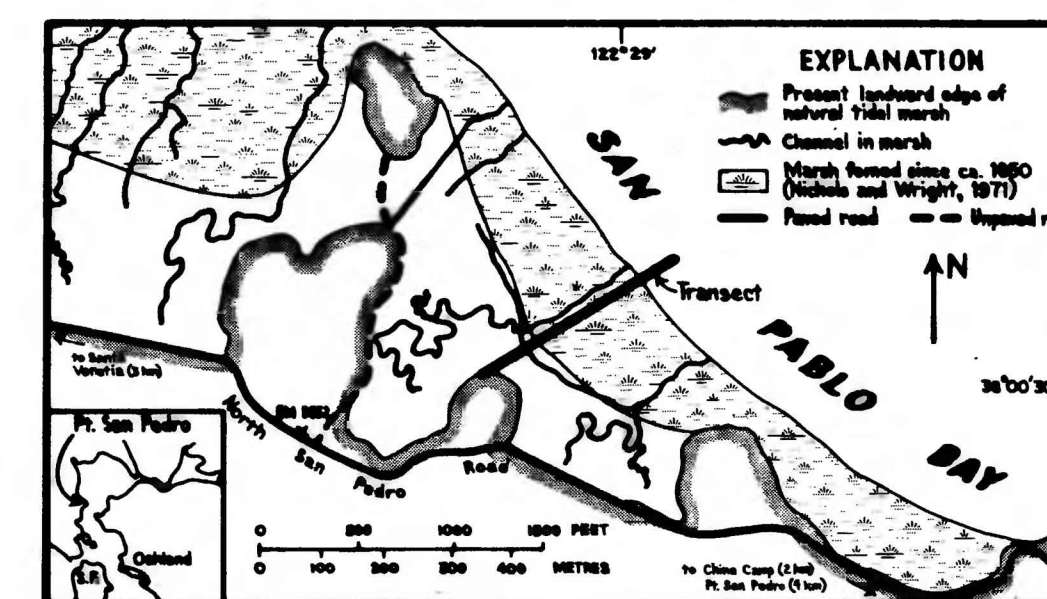
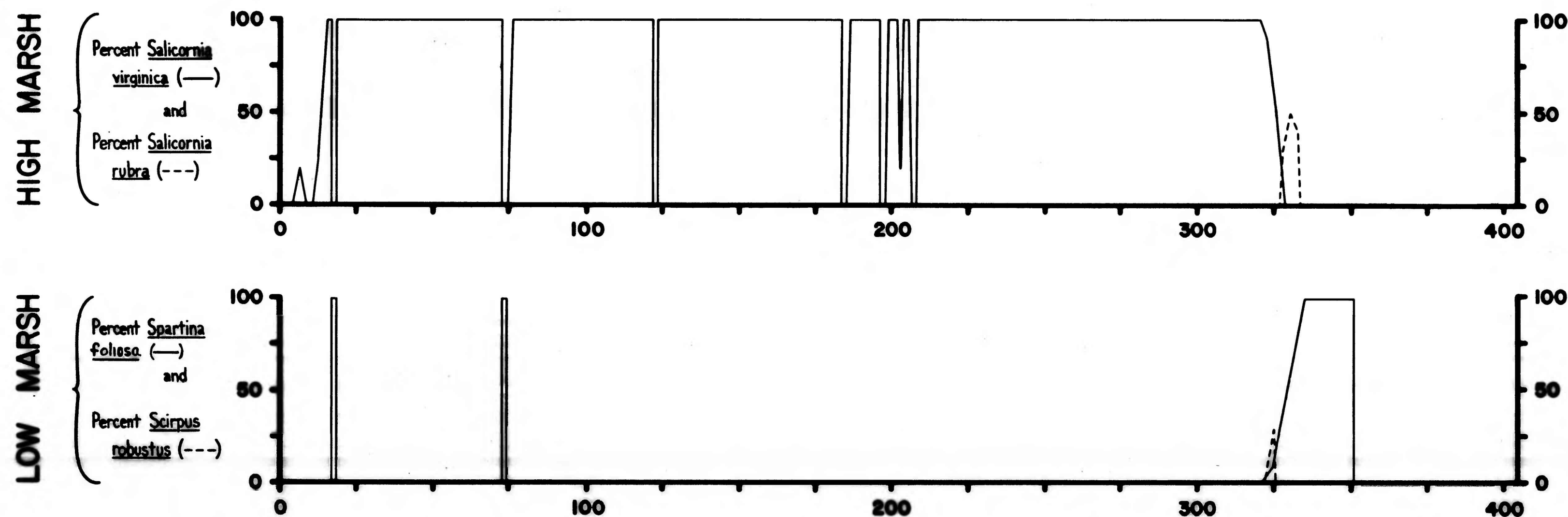

Field work done August 14, 1975. Elevations referenced to U.S. Coast & Geodetic Survey bench mark D552, elevation 12.557 m (41.201 ft) in 1956. The National Geodetic Vertical Datum was formerly called the U.S.C. & G.S. sea-level datum of 1929. Percentage abundance of plants at each data point visually estimated from their areal abundance within a circle of 1-metre radius. Locations of data points indicated by dots on the topographic profile.
