Depth and total thickness of coal in each coal bed 2.5 ft or more thick are shown on right and left side, respectively, of the columnar sections. Total thickness of noncoal partings in each of these beds is shown in parentheses. Coal beds 1.5 to 2.5 ft thick are shown by solid lines with no depth or thickness indicated. Coal beds less than 1.5 ft thick or coal beds of doubtful thickness, position, or existence are shown by half-lines in the columnar sections. All measurements are in feet to the nearest 0.5 ft. To convert to metres multiply by 0.3048.
