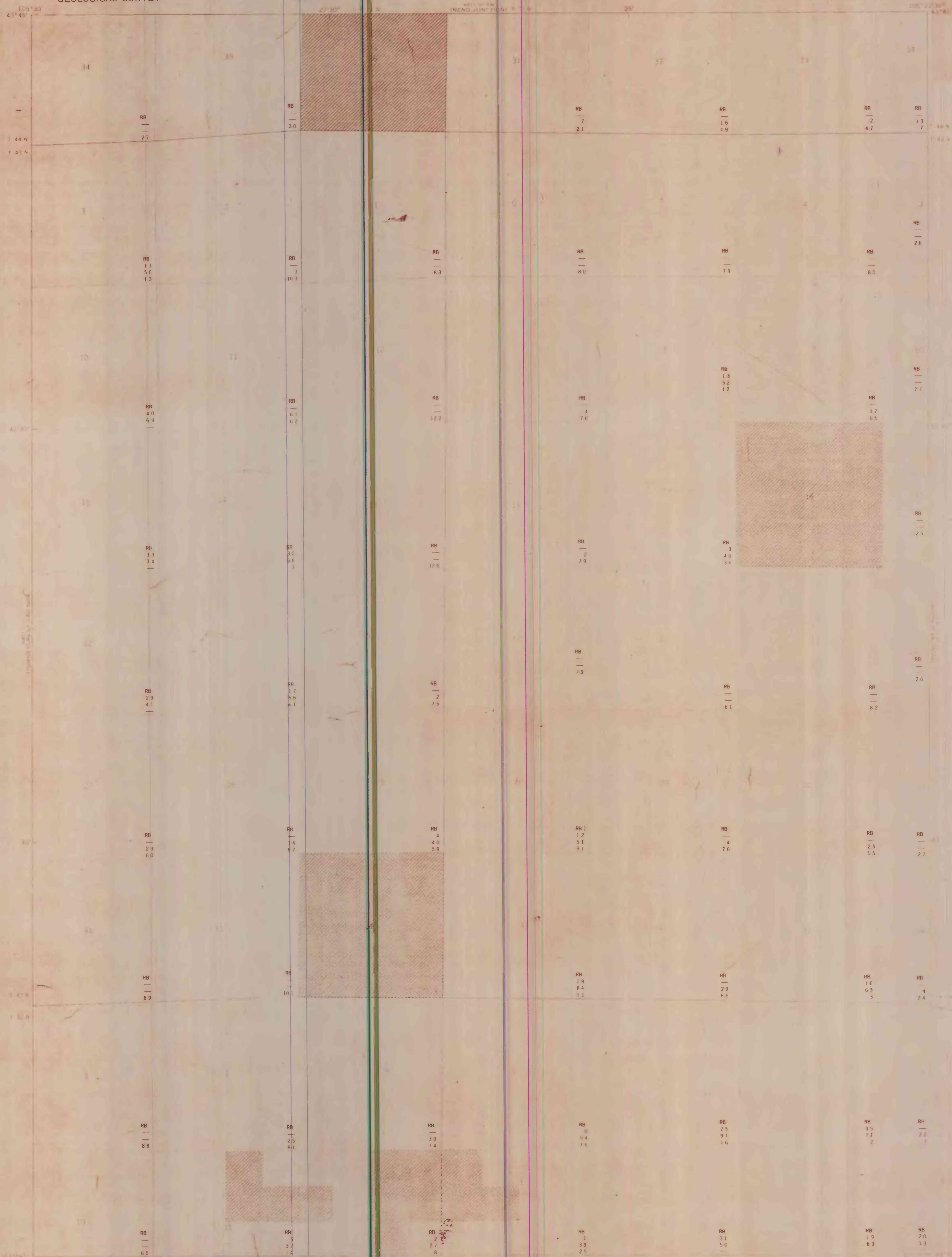

IDENTIFIED COAL RESOURCES OF THE MANNING COAL BED—Showing totals for Reserve Base (RB), in millions of short tons, for each section or part of section of Federal coal land.

Recovery factors have not been established for underground or in situ development of the Manning coal bed in this quadrangle. Therefore, Reserves (R) were not calculated for the Manning coal bed.

To convert short tons to metric tonnes multiply short tons by 0.9072.
