




EXPLANATION

 NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND—Land for which the Federal Government does not own the coal rights.

 STRIPPING-LIMIT LINE—Boundary for surface mining of the Wyodak coal bed (in this quadrangle, the 500-foot-overburden isopach). Arrows point toward the area suitable for surface mining. Recovery factor of 90 percent within that area in this quadrangle.



BOUNDARY LINES—Enclosing areas of measured, indicated, and inferred coal resources of the Wyodak coal bed. Dashed where projected from adjacent quadrangles.
